Reserve Office Training Corps (ROTC)



Two most common myths:

1. You need a scholarship to be in ROTC. FALSE.
-The Guard pays. No scholarship required.
2. You need to go to a school with a ROTC program. FALSE.
-Need to be full time in a 4 year degree program at any accredited college or university.

Advanced Dedicated ARNG Scholarships can be awarded a DedARNG scholarship upon enlistment into the NYARNG and 2 years out from joining ROTC who meet the following gates:

- Enlisted for 6 yrs into the NYARNG & maintain good standings
- Enroll into college by the following fall semester and be a full time student
- Must meet & maintain ROTC enrollment eligibility requirements
- Must be able to be commission before his 31st birthday
- Must be contract SMP/E5 within 3 years with the NYARNG
- Scholarship is only for sophomore through senior year of college or a two year master degree program

The National GUARD ROTC Enlistment Program is when the newly enlisted ARNG soldier attends the summer ROTC six weeks Leadership Development Course (LDC) and the ROTC command approves an exception to policy waiver to accept LDC in lieu-of nine weeks Basic Combat Training (BCT).

The Two year ROTC Program. For prior service (Basic Combat Training Qualified) soldiers can contract with ROTC at the beginning of their sophomore year to be fenced from deployment and to start receiving the ROTC Stipend. Age limit is 30 years old with waivers for Prior Service.

Program info:

- 3x a week PT from 0600-0700 M, W, F.
- Class once a week (One to four hours long).
- Lab every two to three weeks (4 hours).
- FTX (MUTA 6) once a semester
- Training is primarily infantry squad tactics, battle drills, Troop Leading Procedures (TLPs) and OPORD planning
- Receive monthly stipend between \$300-\$500 per month based upon Military Science (MS) year.
- PS soldiers, receive GI Bill (\$297/m) and Kicker (\$350/m) benefits
- GRFD (Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty) Scholarships available. Recommended only if attending a private or out of state school.
- Cadet must be in a full time, 4 year degree program. If an applicant has a bachelor's degree, they can pursue a Master's degree (2 years required).

ROTC Educational Benefits (4 years period) not including Guard benefits

- None deployable when contracted Future Earnings
- Monthly Stipend (\$300-500 per month) \$14,600
- Simultaneous Membership Program Monthly Pay (E-5) \$250 per month.
- Allows up to 3 years of real leadership experience in a unit. \$10,400
- \$10,000 Commissioning Bonus with the Army National Guard **Plus**
- **Uncap** Scholarships Available (3, 2.5 and 2 years)
- \$4,300 yr for Room/Board or meals
