

FRG 101

An FRG is an organization of the families of service members (Volunteers). It works best when supported by both full-time service members and family members. A FRG is made up of volunteers who provide social and emotional support. As well as outreach services and information to family members prior to, during, and after separations (deployments, TDY, AT etc.)

- SECRETARY * optional position
- COMMUNICATION TREE CHAIRPERSON
- GRATUITOUS VOLUNTEERS, FAMILIES, UNIT MEMBERS, COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS etc...

FRG LEAD VOLUNTEERS/CO LEADS

Supervisor : Commander or appointed MPOC

Description of duties:

- Supports Commander's Family Readiness Goals
- Provides overall leadership of the FRG in accordance of AR 608-1, Appendix J
- Schedules, plans, and conducts FRG meetings
- Delegates FRG responsibilities to select volunteers in order to promote participation in FRG activities and accomplishment of FRG objectives.
- Identifies needs or unique problems of unit families and works with Family Programs and unit to offer support
- Acts as FRG spokesperson for communicating family members concerns and ideas to the Company Commander and Battalion level FRG

FRG 101

TREASURER:

- OBTAIN A TAX ID (EIN) NUMBER
- OPEN A NON INTEREST BEARING CHECKING ACCOUNT IN THE NAME OF THE FRG
- TRACK ACCURATE RECORDS OF THE FUND ACCOUNT
- REPORT FUND INFORMATION TO THE FRG AND UNIT COMMANDER AS REQUESTED
- PROVIDE QUARTERLY FUND REPORT TO THE FAMILY PROGRAM OFFICE

FUND ACCOUNT CO SIGNER:

- ASSIST TREASURER AS NEEDED
- CO SIGN ALL CHECKS WRITTEN FROM THE FUND ACCOUNT AND FUND REPORTS

FRG 101

- COMMANDER HAS CONTROL ON FUNDRAISING AND FUND ACCOUNT CAP
- FRG DOES IN ARMORY FUNDRAISING ONLY
- STATUTORY APPOINTED VOLUNTEERS CANNOT FUNDRAISE OUTSIDE OF THE ARMORY
- GRATUITOUS VOLUNTEERS FUNDRAISE AS PRIVATE CITIZENS AND DONATE TO THE FRG
- ONLY GRATUITOUS VOLUNTEERS CAN SOLICIT OR ACCEPT DONATIONS
- FUNDS USEAGE REQUIRES COMMAND APPROVAL AND SHOULD BENEFIT THE ENTIRE FRG


