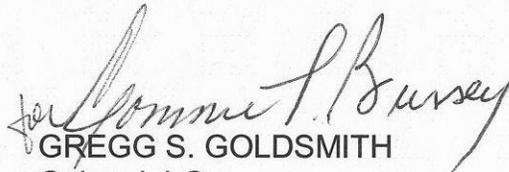

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Implementation of the Army Food Management Information System (AFMIS) for the Army National Guard

1. References. (See AR 30-22, Army Food Program)
2. Effective 01 October 2013, the Army Food Management Information System (AFMIS) will be used by ARNG units to order all food items, contract/catered meals and operational rations; IAW AR 30-22, 5-9 Ordering subsistence.
3. The AFMIS program is the only automated program that is recognized by the Army National Guard (ARNG) for Food Service Management. The AFMIS program is the Standard Army Information System (STAMIS) for food service management. The AFMIS program initial fielding and training is complete. All States, Territories and District of Colombia have received this training.
4. If AFMIS is unavailable due to lack of internet connectivity, the mandatory accounting system will be Reserve Component Subsistence System, IAW AR 30-22, 3-32 Reserve Component Subsistence System. Additional training can be arranged through ILS-E, Senior Food Service Advisor, for personnel within the ARNG.
