**MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD**

**SUBJECT: Army Food Management Information System Reserve Component (AFMIS-RC)**

1. ILS-E Senior Food Service Technician along with the Senior Food Advisor from the EAGLE and a working group comprised of each region have reviewed the Army Food Management Information System Reserve Component (AFMIS-RC) developed by Software Engineering Center- Lee (SEC-Lee). This program is the Standard Army Management Information Systems (STAMIS) system for Food Service and is also the automated program that is being used in theater.
2. The AFMIS program has been updated and is compatible with the Reserve Component Subsistence System (RCSS). The AFMIS program has met the EAGLE's goal for an automated food service program and will bring the Army National Guard to the same level as Active Army and Army Reserve.
3. The AFMIS program is the only automated food service program that is recognized by ILS.
4. The AFMIS program is currently being fielded with the assistance of SEC-Lee.
5. It is recommended that a block of instruction be taught at the National Guard Professional Education Center as part of LTC-006, Food Service Management Course.
