SUBJECT: Letter of Instruction (LOI) 16-01 - Philip A. Connelly Program FY 2016

1. References:

2. The Philip A. Connelly Program is cosponsored by the International Food Service Executives Association (IFSEA), and DCS, G-4. Participation in the competition provides units the opportunity to display the skill, knowledge and teamwork of their 92G personnel while sustaining the mission. The Connelly competition is comprised of three categories, Military Garrison, Active Field feeding, and Reserve and National Guard Field (combined). The Reserve and National Guard category evaluation consists of one lunch meal prepared utilizing A Rations.

3. Additional procedures and criteria for the competition are listed in AR 30-22, paragraph 3-49 and NYARNG Regulation 30-22, Chapter 9. The 2016 Connelly menu and the site layout will be made available to each competing unit prior to the state level competition.

4. The GOCOMs must submit a Connelly competition logistic support cost estimate and a unit information sheet with site location, primary and alternate date for the state level competition to MNL-LM (SS) NLT 31 December 2015. (See enclosures)

5. The state level competition will be conducted from 1 January to 31 March 2016. Each GOCOM will nominate up to 2 units. Each site location must be large enough to establish the field feeding site in the manner it will be evaluated during the regional level competition. Representatives from this office will evaluate the state level competing units. The winner will represent the NYARNG at the regional level competition. Representatives from the Phillip A. Connelly Committee will evaluate the regional level competing units. The regional level competing unit must provide a Connelly logistic support cost estimate and a unit information sheet with a site location, primary and alternate date NLT 31 March 2016.
