BALDWIN, CHAUNCEY.—Age, 34 years. Enlisted, January 20, 1864, at Buffalo; mustered in as private, Co. M, January 26, 1864, to serve three years; captured, January 2, 1864, at Bethesda Church; died, September 2, 1864, at ANDERSONVILLE, Ga. [the proper date is June 2, 1864]

BANCROFT, WILLIAM J.—Age, 19 years. Enlisted, December 9, 1863, at Canandaigua; mustered in as corporal, Co. L, January 19, 1864, to serve three years; killed, June 2, 1864, at Cold Harbor, Va.

BARTON, JOHN M.—Age, 20 years. Enlisted, February 9, 1864, at Auburn, mustered in as private, Co. I, February 19, 1864, to serve three years; captured, June 2, 1864, at Cold Harbor, Va.; paroled, November 24, 1864, at Savannah, Ga.; died of disease, December 12, 1864, at Hospital, Annapolis, Md.

BEECH, ADDISON T.—Age, 20 years. Enlisted, December 31, 1863, at Canandaigua; mustered in as private, Co. H, January 7, 1864, to serve three years; captured, June 11, 1864; died, July 23, 1864, at ANDERSONVILLE, Ga.; also borne as Buck.

Not commissioned as first lieutenant; commissioned captain, February 2, 1864, with rank from January 26, 1864, original.
