“Bloody Lane” Battle of Antietam

This list was prepared from a photocopy of an original casualty list I found in the National Archives, Washington, D.C., with entries from the “Annual Report of the Adjutant General of the State of New York,” which is the 88th New York unit roster, and other sources. The names are placed in the same order as they are in the original list. When there is a difference between the spelling of a name in the original list, and the unit roster, I have used the name in the roster.

Field And Staff

James B. Turner Age 28 years. Enrolled on January 2, 1862, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as first lieutenant, Company F, on

Company A

Patrick Burns age 35 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company A, on December 13, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Denis Hogarty age 28 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company A, on November 11, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Thomas Martin age 30 years. Enlisted on September 17, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 19, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1861.

James Clarke age 20 years. Enlisted on September 12, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 16, 1861. Promoted to corporal in March or April, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1861. He deserted on May 24, 1863, at Falmouth, Va.

Dudley Byrne age 21 years. Enlisted at Newport News, Va., to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company A, on August 23, 1862. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on January 2, 1863, at Philadelphia, Pa.

Thomas Bird age 20 years. Enlisted on September 12, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company A, on September 16, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on November 28, 1862, at Emory Hospital, Washington, D. C. Born in Ireland. Certificate of Disability for Discharge, dated November 26, 1862: “Gun shot wound through the right carpus, injuring the tendon, and rendering the hand almost useless. Disability total.”

Terence Clark age 25 years. Enlisted on September 27, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 28, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 18, 1862, at Emory Hospital, Washington, D. C.

Michael Finn age 20 years. Enlisted on September 12, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 16, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. He died of his wounds on October 9, 1862, at Frederick, Maryland. His name appears in a Roll of Honor for Mount Olivet Cemetery, Frederick, Md., Area M, western side of cemetery, as follows: Michael Finn Pvt Co A October 9, 1862. He is buried in Antietam National Cemetery, Section 25 New York Grave Number 162

John Kennedy age 27 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private,

Company A, on December 13, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Captured in action on May 3, 1863, at Chancellorsville, Va. Paroled, no date. Re-enlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. He deserted on the expiration of furlough, on February 13, 1864.

Francis Lenehan age 21 years. Enlisted on September 4, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 23, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on July 2, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa. Mustered out on October 3, 1864

John McAnally age 29 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company A, on October 21, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Re-enlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. Mustered out with company on June 30, 1865, at Alexandria, Va., as McNally.

Patrick Meehan age 38 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company A, on August 7, 1862. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on May 3, 1863, at Chancellorsville, Va. Mustered out on June 3, 1865, at Washington, D.C.

Joseph O'Hara age 32 years. Enlisted on September 18, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 19, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va. Promoted to corporal, no date. Re-enlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. Deserted on expiration of furlough on February 13, 1864.

James Reynolds age 25 years. Enlisted on September 12, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company A, on September 16, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va. Reenlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. Wounded in action on August 14, 1864, at Deep Bottom, Va. Discharged for disability on March 18, 1865, at Washington, D. C.

Company B

John Ryan age 30 years. Enlisted on September 12, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company B, on September 20, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Patrick Casey age not stated. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company B, on February 7, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, leg, on September 17, 1862. No further record.

John Fitzgibbons age 20 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company B, on October 15, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863, consolidation. He deserted on June 18, 1863, at Sangsters Station, Va.

Paul Kenne age 22 years. Enlisted on December 7, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company B, on December 10, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on March 13, 1863, at Baltimore, Maryland.

John Meagher age 22 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company B, on March 14, 1862. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on January 3, 1863, at Baltimore, Md. His name appears in the casualty list as Maher.

James Davis age 38 years. Enlisted on November 26, 1861, at Oswego, New York, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company B, on November 27, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, leg amputate,

on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on November 17, 1862, at Frederick, Md.

Company C

John O'Connell Joyce age 21 years. Enrolled on September 10, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as first lieutenant, Company C, on September 30, 1861. Mustered in as captain on July 4, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862. Commissioned first lieutenant on December 31, 1861, with rank from

Florence O'Sullivan age 23 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as corporal, Company C, on November 12, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

William McCarthy age 37 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on September 18, 1861. Promoted to corporal, no date. Killed in action on September 17, 1861.

Michael Connery age 18 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on November 30, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

James Darcy age 26 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 22, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Jeremiah Durick age 26 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on September 28, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

John F. Dunne age not stated. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on February 1, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

William Kearns age 25 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on November 26, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Patrick McTeguha age 24 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on September 23, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862. This name is hard to read on the casualty list.

Anthony Webb age not stated. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on December 13, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Richard S. Harrison age 23 years. Enrolled at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as corporal, Company C, on October 2, 1861. Promoted to sergeant on July 3, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863, consolidation. Re-enlisted

as a veteran on December 31, 1862.

Michael Manning age 23 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as corporal, Company C, on October 18, 1861. Wounded in action on June 30, 1862, at White Oak Swamp, Va. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863, consolidation. Transferred to Veteran Reserve Corps, on April 10, 1864.

Thomas Quinn age 26 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as corporal, Company C, on September 17, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 14, 1862, at Fort Hamilton, New York Harbor.

Michael Joyce age 25 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 2, 1861. He was promoted to corporal, no date. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on February 6, 1863, at Convalescent Camp, Va.
CHECK ROSTER ENTRY

John Collins age 37 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 15, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862. The casualty list states "wounded mortally (since dead)."

Michael Collins age 25 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on December 11, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on February 13, 1863, at Convalescent Camp, Va.

John Hayes age 30 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 5, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 6, 1862, at Frederick, Maryland.

Timothy Keegan age 21 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on September 17, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. No further record.

John McFadden age 19 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on September 19, 1861. Wounded in action, dangerously, on September 17, 1862. Deserted, no date.

Michael Larkin age 40 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on November 15, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863, consolidation. Re-enlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. Mustered out with company on June 30, 1865, at Alexandria, Va. His name is also borne as Larkins.

Martin McGowan age 32 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on December 9, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on January 8, 1863, at Philadelphia, Pa.

James McGrath age 33 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on December 7, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863. Wounded in action on June 16, 1864, at Petersburg, Va. He died of his wounds on August 20, 1864, at Philadelphia, Pa.

John Nash age 23 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 24, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 5, 1862, at Harrisburg, Pa.

Charles O'Brien age 28 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 16, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 13, 1862, at Frederick, Md.

Patrick O'Neil age 28 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on December 4, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. He died of his wounds on September 30, 1862, at Frederick, Md.

William L. D. O'Grady age 21 years. Enrolled at New York City, to serve three years.

John Reynolds age 24 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on October 12, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Missing in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va.; no further record.

Mark Tevnen age 26 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company C, on September 19, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Promoted corporal, no date. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863. Promoted to sergeant, no date. Wounded in action on July 2, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa. Re-enlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. Mustered out with company on June 30, 1865, at Alexandria, Va., as Terenin.

Company D

John Murphy age 31, years. Enlisted at New York city, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on October 12, 1861. Promoted to sergeant, no date. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

James McGrath age 35 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on October 11, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Polk Joyce age 18 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on October 23, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Patrick O'Brien age 30 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on November 29, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, head, on September 17, 1862. Promoted to sergeant, no date. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863, consolidation. Returned to ranks, no date. Captured in action on July 2, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa. Returned to company on October 7, 1863. Re-enlisted as a veteran on January 4, 1864. Wounded in action on May 5, 1864, at the Wilderness, Va. Transferred to Veteran Reserve Corps, on April 1, 1865. Mustered out as of Company G, Twelfth Regiment, V.R.C., on July 31, 1865, at Washington, D. C. His name is also borne as Patrick Brien.

Paul Diver age 35 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on October 24, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, arm and chest, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 17, 1862, at Baltimore, Maryland.

Thomas Rainey age 26 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on November 23, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, leg, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on November 17, 1862, at Fort McHenry, Baltimore, Md. His name is also borne as Ramsey, and it appears that way in the original list.

John Donohoe age 23 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on October 11, 1861. Wounded in action, head, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on February 4, 1863, at Convalescent Camp, Va. His name is also borne as Donovan, and it appears as Donovan in the original list.

Charles Fay age 35 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on December 2, 1861. Wounded in action on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on January 16, 1865, at Convalescent Camp, Va.

Lawrence McAuliffe age 28 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company I, on December 11, 1861. Transferred to Company D, no date. Wounded in action on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863. Re-enlisted as a veteran on December 31, 1863. Mustered out with company on June 30, 1865, at Alexandria, Va.

John Teirney age 38 years. Enlisted at New York city, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on December 10, 1861. Wounded in action on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on November 28, 1862, at Fort McHenry, Baltimore, Md.

Patrick O'Connor age 22 years. Enlisted on September 24, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company E, on September 29, 1861. Promoted to corporal, no date. Killed in action on September 17, 1862. He appears in the casualty list as a sergeant.

Joseph McManamy age 33 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company E, on October 1, 1861. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Patrick Cannon age not stated. Enlisted at Milton, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company E, on August 11, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

John Martin age 31 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company E, on October 14, 1861. Promoted to corporal, no date. Promoted to sergeant, on January 1, 1862. Wounded in action, severely, neck, on September 17, 1862. Mustered out on June 12, 1863, at Morrisville, Va. His name is also borne at Morton.

Timothy Eagan age 24 years. Enlisted on September 17, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company E, on September 19, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for wounds on December 6, 1862, at Frederick, Md.

James -----? Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862.

Mathew English age 40 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company E, on October 23, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863. Discharged for disability on December 31, 1863, at Convalescent Camp, Va.

Patrick Coghlin age 40 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company E, on November 22, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862, Discharged for disability on January 24, 1863, at Convalescent Camp. Va.

John Fitzpatrick age 18 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in a private, Company E, on October 14, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on April 8, 1863, at Philadelphia, Pa.

William Whelan age 26 years. Enlisted on October 7, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company E, on October 10, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. He died of his wounds on October 6, 1862, at Frederick, Md.

Michael Hayden age 23 years. Enlisted on September 16, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company E, on September 18, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company A on June 12, 1863. Transferred to Veteran Reserve Corps in February, 1864. His name is also borne as Haydon and Haiden.

Patrick Doonan age 30 years. Enlisted on September 18, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as corporal, Company E, on September 27, 1861. Returned to ranks, no date. Wounded in action, severely, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for wounds on March 18, 1863.

Company F

Patrick Feeney age 34 years. Enlisted on November 22, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company H, on November 30, 1861. Transferred to Company F, on March 1, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

John Griffiths age 25 years. Enlisted on December 31, 1862, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, company F, on January 2, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Hugh Kelly age 21 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company F, on February 27, 1862, Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

Patrick Kinsela age 42 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company F, on January 17, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862.

John Leary age 19 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company F, on January 21, 1862. Killed in action on September 17, 1862. His name is also borne as Leahy, and it appears that way in the casualty list.

Thomas -----? Wounded in action, both legs, on September 17, 1862.

Peter McKenna age 28 years. Enlisted on November 22, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years.

Mustered in as private, Company H, on November 30, 1861. Transferred to Company F on March 1, 1862. Wounded in action, severely, body, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on January 17, 1863, at Convalescent Camp, Alexandria, Va.

Austin McCue age 36 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company F, on January 20, 1862. Wounded in action, side, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on November 23, 1862, at Convalescent Camp, Alexandria, Va.

James Smith age 30 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company F, on February 1, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, arm, on September 17, 1862. Killed in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va.

James Carr age 23 years. Enlisted on December 2, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company F, on January 2, 1862. Promoted to first sergeant on September 13, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, neck, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company B on June 12, 1863. He deserted on October 10, 1863, at New York City.

Thomas H. O'Brien age 22 years. Enrolled at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company F, on January 7, 1862. Mustered in as second lieutenant on September 13, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, breast, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va. Promoted to first lieutenant, Company A, on January 21, 1863. Commissioned second lieutenant on October 17, 1862, with rank from September 13, 1862, vice Ignatius Fox, dismissed. Commissioned first lieutenant on March 23, 1863, with rank from January 21, 1863, vice R. C. Ray, resigned. Discharged on January 28, 1864. Prior service in Company H, Second Infantry (NY).

Company G

Michael Eagan age 25 years. Enrolled at Jersey City, N. J., to serve three years, and mustered in as first lieutenant, Company G, on October 11, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, leg, on September 17, 1862. Mustered in as captain, Company G, on September 22, 1862. Commissioned first lieutenant, on December 31, 1861, with rank from December 15, 1861, original. Commissioned captain on October 9, 1862, with rank from September 22, 1862, vice W. C. Hawksworth, dismissed. Mustered out on consolidation, on June 12, 1863.

William Walsh age 21 years.

Niel McLaughlin age not stated. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company D, on February 12, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, arm, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va. He died of his wounds on March 1, 1863, at Boston, Mass.

Andrew McQuirk age 20 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company G, on February 27, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, leg, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on December 22, 1862, at Baltimore, Md.

Company H

William Crocker age 29 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company H, on February 7, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, thigh, on September 17, 1862. Discharged for disability on March 31, 1863, at David's Island, New York Harbor. His name is also borne as Walter Croker.

Patrick Connelly age not stated. Enlisted on February 4, 1862, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company H, on February 12, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, thigh, on September 17, 1862. Transferred to Company B on June 12, 1863. Mustered out on February 13, 1865, at New York City. His name is also borne as Connolly.

Company I

Thomas Berry age 22 years. Enlisted on September 23, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company I, on September 24, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, leg, on September 17, 1862. Promoted to corporal, Company B, on June 12, 1863. Re-enlisted as a veteran on February 20, 1864. Captured in action on March 25, 1865, at Petersburg, Va. Paroled on April 1, 1865. Mustered out with company on June 30, 1865, at Alexandria, Va.

James McCarty age not stated. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company I, on August 31, 1862. Wounded in action, severely, shoulder, on September 17, 1862. No further record. His name is also borne as McCarthy.

John Debar age 24 years. Enlisted on September 23, 1861, at New York City, to serve three years. Mustered in as private, Company I, on September 27, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, leg, on September 17, 1862. He died of his wounds on November 26, 1862, at Frederick, Md. His name is also borne as Dever, and it appears that way in the casualty list.

Timothy J. Plunkett age 25 years. Enrolled at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company I, on February 3, 1862. Wounded in action, slightly, on September 17, 1862. Wounded in action on December 13, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va. Transferred to Company B on June 12, 1863. Wounded in action, July, 1863, at Gettysburg, Pa. Commissioned first lieutenant, not mustered, on December 7, 1864, with rank from September 15, 1864, vice W. J. O'Connor, promoted.

Nicholas McGuire age 19 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company K, on October 2, 1861. Wounded in action, severely, arm, on September 17, 1862. Deserted in January, 1863, from hospital, Philadelphia, Pa.

James Staples Age 18 years. Enlisted at New York City, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Company K, on October 16, 1861. Wounded in action, slightly, face, on September 17, 1862. No further record.
