ADDY, THOMAS.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. G, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to April 10, 1863; as first sergeant, March 1, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; ' died of diarrhea, November 11, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Mother applies January 17, 1866*]

BORSOS, JOHN.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted-, September 13, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. I, October 7, 1862; wounded in action, May 24, 1864, at North Anna River, Va.; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, about March 24, 1865; mustered out, June 30, 1865, at Munson's Hill, Va. ; also borne as Brosas and Borosos. [*Applies as invalid on July 13, 1875; died in 1908*]

BURKE, THOMAS.—Age, 39 years. Enlisted, August 16, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; wounded and captured: in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, no date; died of diarrhea, October 6, 1864, at Annapolis, Md. [*Application for minor's pension filed on July 24, 1865*]

CARLAND, BERNARD.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 29, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, no date; discharged for disability, June 13, 1865. [*Applied as invalid on Sept. 20, 1875; died December 14, 1899*]

CLANCY, DENNIS.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, September 2, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died, October, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*] [*see Civil War letters of John Rooney*]

COOGAN, FRANCIS G.—Age, 23 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to August, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died of paralysis, October 19, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

COPE, WILLIAM H.—Age, 33 years. Enlisted, August 22, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, September 3, 1864; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, near Washington, D. C. [*NPAF*]

CORCORAN, JOHN.—Age, 25 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years-; mustered in as private, Co. I, October 7, 1862; promoted sergeant prior to April , 1863; sergeant-major, April 8, 1863; retransferred as sergeant to Co. I prior to July 24, 1863; returned to ranks prior to April, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, November 25, 1864; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, near Washington, D.C. [*NPAF*]

CUSHMAN, WILLIAM.—Age, 38 years. Enlisted, September

20, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. F, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died of disease, September 20, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga. [*NPAF*]

DAVRIN , PATRICK.—Age, 42 years. Enlisted, September 12, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. G, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, May 1, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, December 27, 1864; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, near Washington, D. C.; also borne as Devera [*NPAF*]

DELANEY , JOHN.—Age, 28 years. Enlisted. September 1, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; escaped, March 10, 1865, from Salisbury, N. C. ; discharged, June 30, 1865, at Munson's Hill , Va. ; also borne as Delancy. [*Applies as invalid on January 19, 1883; died August 24, 1893*]

DE ST. MAURICE, EDWARD.—Age, — years. Enlisted, September 8, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. K, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to April 10, and sergeant, August 31, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, October, 1864; promoted first sergeant, January 1, 1865; sergeant-major, March 9, 1865; mustered out while on furlough, July 15, 1865, as Edward D. [*NPAF*]

DONOVAN, CORNELIUS.—Age, 39 years. Enlisted, September 13, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. H, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died, January, 1865, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Application filed for minor on July 17, 1865*]

DORMER, JOHN.—Age, 38 years. Enlisted, August 28, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. E, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, September 24, 1864; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, at Washington, D.C. [*Correct name is Dorman; Application by widow and minor on October 26, 1874*]

DORSY, PATRICK.—Age, 37 years. Enlisted, September 9, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died of ophthalmia, at Salisbury, N. C.; also borne as Dorcey.[*Widow applies on September 11, 1865*]

DOUGHERTY, JOHN.—Age, 28 years. Enrolled, September 3, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. K, October 7, 1862; promoted sergeant, no date; returned to ranks, January 2, 1863; again promoted sergeant prior to April 10, 1863; first sergeant prior to August, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864; paroled, October, 1864; promoted, sergeant-major, January 1, 1865; mustered in as first lieutenant, Co. A, to date December 28, 1864; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, at Washington, D. C.; also borne as Doherty. [*applies as invalid on August 7, 1888; died 1906*] Commissioned first lieutenant, February 28, 1865, with rank from December 28, 1864, vice D. J. Mykens promoted.

DURKIN, WILLIAM.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, September 3, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; promoted first sergeant prior to April 10, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at

Ream's Station, Va.; died, November 29, 1864, while a prisoner of war. [*NPAF*]

FEELEY, JAMES.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 15, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; died of debility, November 17, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C.; also borne as Fely. [*Mother applies on July 14, 1865*]

FEHER, LOUIS.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, August 9, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. H, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, no date; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, February 24, 1865; mustered out with detachment, June 26, 1865, at Munson's Hill, Va., as Faiher. [*NPAF*]

FINIGHTY, OWEN.—Age, 43 years. Enlisted, August 29, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, no date; died of disease, November 15, 1864, at hospital, Annapolis, Md.; also borne as Finerty. [*Widow/minor application on January 9, 1865*]

FREELAN, JAMES.—Age, 22 years. Enrolled, August 22, 1862, at Brooklyn, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, October 7, 1862; promoted sergeant, prior to April 10, 1863; mustered in as first lieutenant, Co. H, July 4, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled in February, 1865, and returned to company, April 12, 1865, mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, near Washington, D.C.; also borne as Freeland. [*died August 5, 1918 at Woodhaven, NY*] Commissioned first lieutenant, June 23, 1864, with rank from June 9, 1864, vice J. S. Fitzmaurice killed in action.

GRENNAN, MICHAEL.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 24, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. I, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; died, October 28, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

HAWKES, ROBERT.—Age, 32 years. Enlisted, September 5, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. K, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; died, while prisoner of war, December —, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

H EVEY, FRANCIS.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, same date; sergeant, May 30, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, no date; promoted first sergeant, March 1, 1865; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, near Washington, D. C. [*Applied as invalid August 5, 1890; died December 16, 1898*]

HIGGIN, JAMES.—Age, 30 years. Enlisted, September 15, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. G, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to April, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; died of starvation, February 13, 1865, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

JOHNSON, M I C H A E L C.—Age, 39 years. Enlisted, September 9, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, prior to

April, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; died in prison, November 3, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Widow applies on July 25, 1865*]

K E L L Y , WILLIAM.—Age, 32 years. Enlisted, September 12, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, prior to August, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, no date; mustered out, June 22, 1865, at Armory Square Hospital, Washington, D. C. [*NPAF*]

KETTLE , PATRICK.—Age, 31 years; Enlisted, September 2, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; died, December 1, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Kittle is correct name; widow applies on April 14, 1865*]

LEARY , JEREMIAH.—Age, 20 years. Enlisted, August 27, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; died, no date, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

MAHONEY, PATRICK.—Age, 22 years. Enlisted, August 27, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. H, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. paroled, February 26, 1865, at Wilmington, N. C ; mustered out with detachment, June 26, 1865, at Munson's Hill, Va. [*NPAF*]

McCABE, MICHAEL.—Age, 27 years. Enlisted, September 16, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. I, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, no date; sergeant, April 8, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, and died/October 28, 1864, at Salisbury,"N. C. [*Widow applies on August 8, 1865*]

MCCARTHY, DANIEL.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, September 15, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. H, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, prior to August, 1863; returned to ranks, prior to April , 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, February, 1865, and mustered out, June 17, 1865, at Camp Parole, Annapolis, Md. [*Applies as invalid on March 17, 1883; died December 26, 1893*]

MCCARTHY, JOHN.—Age, 22 years. Enlisted, September 3, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. 0, November 7, 1862; promoted corporal, prior to December 18, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; paroled, March 8, 1865; mustered out, June 28, 1865, at Munson's Hill, V a.; also borne as McCarty. [*Applies as invalid on September 1, 1879; died February 9, 1890*]

McGIVENEY, THOMAS—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, August 11, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered an as private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va., and died of diarrhea, October 28, 1864, at Salisbury, NC. [*Father applies on November 26, 1869*]

McGRAND, JOHN.—Age, 45 years. Enlisted, September 20, 1862 at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. F, October 7, 1862; captured in action August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va., and died of intermittent fever, June 17, 1865, at Salisbury, N. C.; also borne as McGrann. [*Correct name is Magrann; Widow applies on April 14, 1865(?)*]

McGRATH, W I L L I A M P.—Age, 28 years. Enlisted, August 1, 1862, at New York city, to. serve three years; mustered in 'as

private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to April 10, 1863; returned to ranks prior to August, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va., and died of diarrhea, October 28, 1864, and "rheumatism," November 12, 1864, at Salisbury, NC. ; also borne as William H. [*Widow applies on May 27, 1865*]

McGUIRE, PHILIP.—Age, 36 years. Enlisted, September 15, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. I, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; mustered out, June 28, 1865, at McDougall Hospital, New York Harbor; also borne as Phillip Maguire. [*Widow applies on May 15, 1885*]

McKELVEY, JOHN.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, September 19, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. F, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to April 10, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va., and died of pneumonia, November 22, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

McNAMARA, JOHN.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 15, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. G, October 7, 1862; promoted sergeant, May 1, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; paroled and returned to duty, April 18, 1865; mustered out with company, July 15, 1865, near Washington, D. C. [*Invalid application, not granted pension circa April 1898*]

O'BOYE, PATRICK.—Age, 34 years. Enlisted, September 11, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. H, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a. ; died, February, 1865, at Richmond, V a.; also borne as O'Boy. [*Widow applies August 8, 1865*]

O'BRIEN, DANIEL.—Age, 27 years. Enlisted, September 13, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. I, October 7, 1862; captured in action, June 16, 1864, at Petersburg, Va.; died, October 28, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Very few men captured at Petersburg; how this man got to Salisbury instead of Andersonville would be interesting to know*]

O'BRIEN, JOHN, 2nd.—Age, 37 years. Enlisted, August 29, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A , October 7, 1862; captured inaction, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died of diarrhea, October 29, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C, as John M. [*two John O'Brien's in Co. A; Widow applies on February 17, 1865*]

O'BRIEN, JOHN.—Age, 23 years. Enlisted, September 13, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. K, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; paroled, no date; mustered out, June 27, 1865, at Elmira, N. Y. [*Applies as invalid on June 3, 1882; no death date given*]

O'BRIEN, JOHN.—Age, 44 years. Enlisted, August 8, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; paroled, no date; died of diarrhea, October 14, 1864, at Annapolis, Md., as John M. [*see above; in general I have observed that those who died after release from Confederate captivity at Camp Parole, Annapolis, MD, were lost in the government's woodworks for awhile and relatives were frequently late in applying for pensions if at all.*]

O'BRIEN, MARTIN.—Age, date of enlistment, place and mustered in as private, Co. A, not stated; captured in action, no

date; died of pneumonia, December 2, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

O'SHANESSY, JOHN.—Age, 23 years. Enlisted, September 17, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. F, October 7, 1862, and promoted corporal; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a. paroled and returned to ranks, no date; mustered out, June 14, 1865, at hospital, Annapolis, Md., as O'Shaurressy. [*Applied as invalid on October 4, 1890; died August 24, 1902*]

PIGOTT, MORRIS.—Age, 33 years. Enlisted, September 4, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. K, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va. ; died, October, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C.; also borne as Maurice Piggott. [*Application for minor pension filed on December 1, 1865*]

REGAN, THOMAS.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, August 25, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. K, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to October 31, 1863, and sergeant, August 31, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; died of diarrhea, November 23, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Widow applies on March 25, 1865*]

SHEEHAN , JOHN.—Age, 22 years. Enlisted, September 9, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. E, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, prior to April 10, 1863; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; paroled, no date; mustered out, June 26, 1865, at Munson's H i l l, Va. [*NPAF*]

SHEEHAN, JOHN.—Age, 43 years. Enlisted, September 11, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. F, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; died, September 20, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga. [*One of two unfortunates to go to Andersonville, both from Co. F. Their death dates there are the same. Andersonville was being emptied out of all but the very sick by early September, 1864.*]

SMITH, CHARLES G.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, August 20, 1862, at Brooklyn, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, J u l y 1, 1864; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; paroled, no date; mustered out, June 20, 1865, at Tilton Hospital, Wilmington, Delaware. [*Applies as invalid on January 16, 1907; the oldest survivor of captivity dies on March 18, 1932*]

THOMAS, CHARLES H.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, August 20, 1862, at Brooklyn, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal, prior to April 10, 1863; returned to ranks and promoted sergeant, no dates; missing in action, August 25, 1861, at Ream's Station, V a.; died of intermittent fever, December 7, 1861, at Salisbury, N. C. [*Father applies for pension on July 17, 1890*]

VON ARN, RANDOLPH.—Age, 32 years. Enlisted, August 25, 1862, at Brooklyn, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. B, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; died of disease, January 16, 1865, at Salisbury, N. C ; also borne as Am. [*Correct name is Von Arx; Mother applies on April 7, 1866*]

WARD, JOHN.---Age, 40 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; missing in action, since August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, Va.; absent since and at muster out of company; also borne as James John. [*1st Lt. Patrick Dunne swears affidavit on 13 November 1867 saying he saw a letter from a Confederate surgeon claiming John Ward died at Columbia, SC, on or about December 26, 1864, see widow's pension application at www.fold3.com*]

WOODS, HENRY,—Age, 21 years Enlisted, September 10,

1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 7, 1862; captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; died, November 15, 1864, at Salisbury, N. C. [*NPAF*]

YOUNG, JAMES.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, August 15, 1862, at New York city, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, October 7, 1862; promoted corporal prior to A p r i l 10, 1863; sergeant, prior to A p r i l 30, 1864; wounded and captured in action, August 25, 1864, at Ream's Station, V a.; paroled, no date; discharged for disability, May 27, 1865, at Chester Hospital, Chester, Pa. [*Applies as invalid on December 1, 1865; died January 4, 1922 at West Allis, Wisconsin*]
