SUBJECT: New York Army National Guard (NYARNG) Implementation of the Extension of Periodic Reinvestigation Timelines

## 1. References.

- a. Memorandum, Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence, 17 January 2017, subject: Extension of Periodic Reinvestigation Timelines to Address the Background Investigation Backlog.
- b. Memorandum, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-2, 2 February 2017, subject: Army Implementation of the Extension of Periodic Reinvestigation Timelines.
- c. Memorandum, National Guard Bureau, 23 February 2017, subject: Army National Guard Implementation of the Extension of Periodic Reinvestigation Timelines.
- 2. Background. In July 2016, the Service Secretaries expressed concern regarding the negative impact that the personnel security investigation backlog is having on Department of Defense (DOD) mission readiness, critical programs, and operations. To assist in mitigating the backlog and risk, the Director of National Intelligence endorsed DOD's plan to extend the timeline for submitting Periodic Reinvestigations.
- 3. General. The revised timelines and requirements for periodic reinvestigations are found below.
- a. Tier 3 Periodic Reinvestigations (T3R), previously known as NACLC, will remain at a periodicity of ten years.
- b. Tier 5 Periodic Reinvestigations (T5R), previously known as Special Background Periodic Reinvestigations (SBPR), will commence six years after the closed date of the previous investigation rather than five years. Submitting T5Rs every five years will be postponed until the current investigation backlog is resolved.
- c. Personnel Security representatives (i.e. G2s and S2s) will continue to submit all Periodic Reinvestigations to the State Personnel Security Manager within 30 days of the background investigation due date, which is the closed date of the previous investigation.
