This analyst works closely with other departments within the Company as well as with regulatory agencies.

- Compiles and analyzes financial and sales data in the preparation of reports and filings with regulatory agencies
- Develops monthly commodity and commodity-related prices
- Analyzes and designs electric and gas delivery rates
- Assists in the development of comprehensive cost of service studies
- Maintains load research program
- Compiles and analyzes load research data for load forecasting purposes
- Prepares and presents expert testimony in regulatory proceedings
- Performs economic and financial analyses of various electric and gas business initiatives

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in Economics, Statistics, Business Administration, Finance, Mathematics or related degree
- Strong analytical, quantitative, organizational, computer and written/verbal communication skills

- Ability to work individually or as a team (with internal team members or cross functional teams)
