Course Attendance Criteria

General: All RTI Courses are posted in ATRRS under School Code 1006. POC for school attendance is your 1st Line Supervisor and unit Readiness NCOs. Attendance requirements are listed below for each course.

91W Reclass: Soldiers with a MOS 91WY2 and have completed the 91B course after 1 October 1988. Soldiers who attended prior to that date or previously held MOS 91C (currently ASI M6) must have completed an EMT-B course with at least 110 Hours in length or be able to demonstrate having previously attended a full 110-hour EMT-B course IAW the 1994 EMT-B Department of Transportation (DOT) curriculum. e Soldier must also have a current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certification at the Healthcare Provider level that will remain current throughout training for Phase II. Soldiers not meeting the prerequisite of completing the 91B course after 1 October 1988 or having previously attended a full 110-hour EMT-B course IAW 1994 EMT-B DOT curriculum is not eligible for this course and must attend the 110-hour EMT-B course

91W Sustainment/Refresher:

88M: Active Army, Reserve Component or Army National Guard enlisted personnel requiring MOS 88M10 qualification. Personnel must have attained a minimum score of 90 in aptitude area-operator and food service (OF), must possess a valid state driver's license which will not expire prior to completion of training. The 88M10 Course is organized into two distinct but interrelated phases:

19D: Individual must have completed Basic Training as a member of any U.S. military service (Active or Reserve Component), must meet the requirements prescribed in AR 611-201 for MOS 19D Cavalry Scout, and must be qualified in an MOS other than 19D (see Special Information). Individual must be in the grade PVT through SFC and not have previously completed a 19D MOS-producing course.

31B: Active Army and Reserve Component enlisted personnel who have successfully completed basic combat training and meet standards prescribed by Department of the Army Regulation 611-201 for MOS 95B.

11B: Selected personnel who require entry-level qualification based on present or projected assignment as an 11B Infantryman.

BNCOC: Active Army or Reserve Component enlisted soldiers that meet enlistment requirements. Selected by PERSCOM (Active Army) or recommended by unit commander (Reserve Component). Qualified in any MOS. Meets requirements outlined in AR 351-1, para 5-14, and met TABE requirements. Active and Reserve soldiers over 40 must complete required medical screening and received status prior to attending. Only SSGs and promotable SGTs will attend. Successfully completed PLDC or equivalent unless promoted prior to linkage of NCOES to promotion. Successfully completed PLDC at least 6 months prior to attending this phase. Meet requirements listed in AR 351-1 (Being replaced by AR 350-1), TR 351-10, and TR 351-18.

OCS: Soldier must have the following: must be a US Citizen or attain citizenship prior to commissioning; have earned 60 credit hours prior to enrollment and 90 credit hours prior to commissioning; must be at least 18 years of age 1, or be commissioned prior to their 30th birthday, waivable to 35th birthday; achieve a General Technical Aptitude Area (GT) Score of 110 or higher on ASVAB Test; meet height and weight standards IAW AR 600-9; must have passed an APFT within 12 months of enrollment; must pass a physical examination IAW AR 40-501, Chapter 2, prior to the start of OCS; have completed basic training, advanced individual training and have served at least one year in a unit; must be capable of possessing a SECRET security clearance upon commissioning; Soldiers must meet the Moral and Administrative Qualifications IAW NGR 600-200, Chapter 2.

Pre-Command Course: Required for Company-level command. Officers with demonstrated potential to serve as unit commanders are recommended for attendance by their chain of command.

Small Group Instruction: Soldier must have completed a TOTAL ARMY INSTRUCTOR COURSE or TRADOC-approved instructor training course and have been assigned as a GROUP LEADER/FACILITATOR.

Total Army Instructor Course: Soldier must be assigned to an instructor or supervisory instructor position on a United States Army military school, college, or training center peacetime or mobilization table of distribution and allowances. Enlisted soldiers must meet assignment prerequisites IAW AR 614-200.
