References: New York Vehicle and Traffic Law §404-d.

- 1. **PURPOSE:** This directive prescribes the policy and procedures for New York Guard members to obtain New York “State Guard” license plates.
- 2. **APPLICABILITY:** This regulation applies to all New York Guard members.
- 3. **SCOPE:** This publication describes procedures to be followed in application for New York Guard Special Plates.
- 4. **POLICY:** It is the policy of the New York Guard that members of the New York Guard who actively participate in the New York Guard are authorized to apply for New York “State Guard” special license plates for their motor vehicles after their first year of service.

Former members of the New York Guard who have retired or with an honorable discharge, with no less than ten (10) years of active service in the New York Guard, may continue to maintain their State Guard plates. Members who do not regularly perform duty or leave without approval may have their privileges revoked.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES:

5.1. New York Guard, Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel and Administration (NYSG-G1) will;

- a. Review applications and provide certification (NYG Form 4515) for qualified members IAW this Directive.
- b. Issue revocation of authorization for plates held by deceased or non-performing members.

5.2. Each member will, adhere to this directive and keep the New York Guard informed as to status.

6. PROCEDURES:

6.1. New York Guard members submit DMV Form MV-412 to the G1. Application must contain payment (either credit card information or a personal check).

6.2. New York Guard (NYSG-G1) will verify the applicant's membership status and drill participation.

6.3. New York Guard (NYSG-G1) will forward a NYG Form 4515 and MV-412 directly to the Custom Plate Unit.

6.4. The member may renew as required by DMV, as long as they remain in good standing. Members who depart under other than honorable conditions may have their renewal privileges revoked.

6.6. Member must confirm receipt of plate and number with G1.

7. DEFINITIONS: None.

8. EFFECTIVE DATE AND IMPLEMENTATION: This Directive is effective immediately.

CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORIZATION

REASSIGNMENT OF PLATE NUMBER: This will certify that the New York Guard plate number _____ previously issued to _____ be reassigned inasmuch as he/she has changed status within the New York Guard; accordingly, New York Guard plate number _____ should now be assigned to _____ to a vehicle registered in their name effective _____.

IMPORTANT: Making a false statement in any registration application or in any proof or statements in connection with it, or deceiving or substituting in connection with this application, is a misdemeanor under Section 392 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, and may also result in the revocation or suspension of the registration pursuant to regulations established by the Commissioner.
