#### President Barack Obama Delivers Annual Proclamation Announcing November as Military Family Appreciation Month

In his speech for this annual proclamation, President Obama called on Americans to “celebrate the (military) families who make daily sacrifices to keep our Nation whole, and we remember a most sacred obligation -- to serve them as well as they serve us.

Military families exemplify the courage and resolve that define our national character. For their country and their loved ones, they rise to the challenges of multiple deployments and frequent moves -- spouses who care and provide for children in their partners' absence, kids who make new friends and leave known comforts behind. They are the force behind the force, patriots who support their family members in uniform while enriching the communities they call home.

#### New York Governor Andrew M. Cuomo Declares November as Military Family Appreciation Month in the State of New York

“During the month of November, we honor New York’s military families, who have made their own sacrifices in the service of our country,” Governor Cuomo said. “When our service members are deployed for a mission overseas or to respond to a domestic emergency, they leave behind spouses, children, siblings and parents, and in many ways, these family members provide the courage and support that allows their loved ones to serve in the U.S. Armed Forces...The legacy of New York State is built upon the courage of the men and women of the U.S. Armed Forces, as well as the many family members who have supported them during both wartime and peacetime. Today there are roughly 30,000 New Yorkers in serving in the National Guard and Reserves, in addition to nearly 900,000 veterans living in New York State.” To view the full proclamation visit

  - D. Service Members preparing to mobilize/deploy and their immediate Family members, and
  - E. All other Guard/Reserve/Active/Veterans and their immediate Family members.
- 6) If you or a guest has a disability restricting standing Respectfully, please only ONE request per family. Chosen participants will be notified via email.
