

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DID YOU KNOW?!

Who is Eligible for TAMP Benefits?

Designed to help separating active duty Service Members and their families, the Transitional Assistance Management Program (TAMP) provides 180 days of transitional health care benefits and two years of base privileges (i.e., commissary, exchange, and Morale, Welfare, and Recreation), under the following conditions:

- Involuntarily separating from active duty based on a specific Separation Program Designator (SPD) code, and Character of Service of “Honorable” or “General (Under Honorable Conditions)”
- A National Guard or Reserve member separating from a contingency operation, if the member served on active duty for 31 or more consecutive days
- Separating from active duty following involuntary retention (stop-loss)
- Separating from active duty following a voluntary agreement to stay on active duty for less than one year in support of a contingency operation
- Separating from active duty due to a sole survivorship discharge
- Separating from active duty and agreeing to become a member of the Selected Reserve of a Reserve component the day immediately following release from regular active duty service. *Note: These Sponsors and family members do not qualify for the two years of base privileges.*
