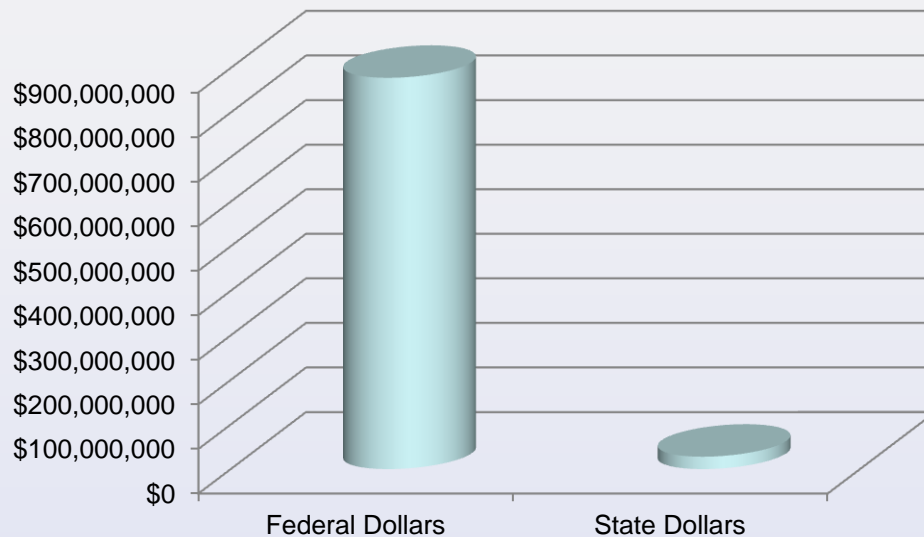


**New York National Guard Economic Impact

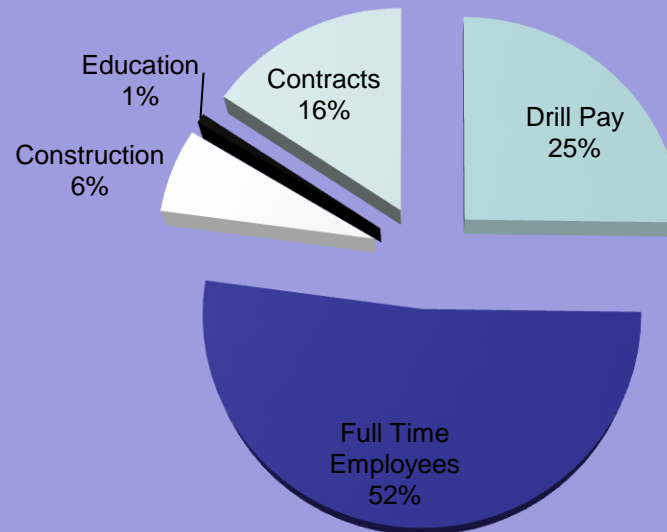
