AMEDD OBLC (Course # 6-8-C20 AMEDD)
26 Day Course with a 40 hour on-line/internet course
for
Medical Corps, Dental Corps, Medical Specialist Corps, Nurse Corps Officers,
And Medical Students

(6 Classes a year in Jan/Apr/Jun/Aug/Sep/Nov)

- Integrates all AMEDD COMPOs together in OBLC POI – promotes teamwork within AMEDD
- Establishes one training standard for all AMEDD Officers
- DL requirements (Phase I RC) will be grandfathered for all RC officers until summer of CY08.

Phase 1 Distributed Learning (DL) - Effective May 2008. Distance Learning (DL)/web base training will replicate didactic classroom instruction provided in the nine-week active duty OBLC. 40 hour internet course must be completed before attending Phase 2. NOT required if you take Phase 2 before 1 May 2008.
