

SUBJECT: Authorization for NYARNG Officer and AGR Personnel to Subsist

1. Reference: AR 30-22, "The Army Food Service Program", Para 3-34, Subsisting Personnel and para. 3-35, Reimbursements. AR 600-20 "Army Command Policy", para. 2-5, Command of installations, activities, and units.
2. Unit Officers and Enlisted Soldiers drawing BAS are authorized and encouraged to subsist at the standard meal rate during IDT periods with their units.
3. Unit Officers not receiving BAS are authorized and encouraged to subsist at the standard meal rate during IDT periods with their units.
4. Commanders authorizing Officers/Enlisted to subsist will establish headcount procedures. Headcounter will be briefed to ask all soldiers of their status prior to allowing payment for meals.
