

10th New York Cavalry casualties at Sulphur Springs, VA on October 12, 1863

ARNOLD, AMOS.— Age, 22 years. Enlisted, August 30, 1862, at Oxford; mustered in as private, Co. K , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; **wounded in action at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**; transferred to Co. K, First New York Provisional Cavalry, June 24, 1865; transferred as Arnold, Amion.[Died February 25, 1915 at Rockdale, NY]

ASHTENAW, JOSEPH F . — Age, 22 years. Enlisted, October 11, 1861, at Bouckville; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 22, 1861, to serve three years; injured and captured at Brandy Station, Va., June 9, 1863; appointed corporal, date not stated; sergeant, September —, 1863; **wounded at Sulphur Springs Va., October 12, 1863**; discharged for disability, November 7, 1864, at Washington, D. C.[Died in 1906]

ASHTON, THOMAS K.— Age, 23 years. Enlisted, September 29, 1862, at Cortlandville; mustered in as corporal, Co. L , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; wounded and captured at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 17, 1863; **died of disease, August 13, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga.**[#5554 at Andersonville National Cemetery][No Pension Application Found/NPAF]

BECKHORN, THOMPSON B.—Age, 34 years. Enlisted, December 32, 1861, at Chemung; mustered in as private, Co. A , December 12, 1861, to serve three years; captured, June 9, 1863, at Brandy Station, Va.; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**; captured at Ground Squirrel Church, Va., May 11, 1864; died, November – 1864, in Andersonville prison. [#6034 at ANC][Widow's pension says he died August 18, 1864; see 64 pages at www.fold3.com]

BINGHAM, GEORGE W.—Age, 19 years. Enlisted, October 1, 1861, at Waverly; mustered in as private, Co. H , November 4, 1861, to serve three years; appointed corporal, October, 1862; **captured** at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; mustered out, January 7, 1865, at Elmira, N.Y.[Died January 22, 1913 at Lockwood, NY]

BLAUVELT, CHARLES E.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, August 30, 1862, at Buffalo; mustered in as corporal, Co. L , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**; **died, October 13, 1863, near Catlett's Station, Va.**[Father applies for a pension in May 1885]

BONNELL, BENJAMIN W.—Age, 24 years. Enlisted, October 1, 1861, at Waverly; mustered in as sergeant, Co. H, November 4, 1861, to serve three years; **captured** at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; appointed quartermaster sergeant,

date not stated; mustered out, May 19, 1865, at Elmira, N.Y.[Died February 4, 1918 at Waverly, NY]

BROWNELL, BENJ. F.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, August 31, 1861, at McGrawville; mustered in as private. Co. A , September 27, 1861, to serve three years; captured at Middleburg, Va., June 19, 1863; **wounded, Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**; mustered out, October 17, 1864, at Elmira, N.Y.[NPAF]

COWLES, JAMES I.—Age, 31 years. Enlisted, November 5, 1861, at Oswell, Pa.; mustered in as bugler, Co. H , November 7, 1861, to serve three years; **captured** at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; paroled prisoner, April 28, 1865; mustered out, July 1, 1865 at New York city. [Died in 1913 at Orwell, PA]

DUDLEY, GIDEON C — Age, 29 years. Enlisted, October 10, 1861, at Watkins; mustered in as corporal, Co. H , October 25, 1861, to serve three years; captured at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; appointed sergeant, no date; **died of disease, July 17, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga.**[Widow applies on August 1, 1865]

EVANS, ELIAS D . — Age, 29 years. Enlisted, November 1, 1861, at Bourkville; mustered in as private, Co. D, November 19, 1861, to serve three years; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va , October 12. 1863**; re-enlisted, December 18, 1863; wounded at Todd's Tavern, Va., May 5, 1864, and at Trevilian Station, Va., June 11, 1864; captured at Brensville, Va., June 18, 1864; paroled, December 22, 1864; transferred, June 24, 1865, to Co. D., First New York Provisional Cavalry. [Appears to have died in 1880]

FARRELL, JOHN. — Age, 21 years Enlisted, September 9, 1862; at Washington; mustered in as private, Co. B, September 9, 1862, to serve three years; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**, and at Lee's Mills, Va., July 30, 1864; discharged, January 3, 1865, at Judiciary Square Hospital, Washington, D. C ; also borne as John W.[Invalided at discharge; no death date given]

HARSH, JACOB H.—Age, 23 years Enlisted, August 24, 1861, at Syracuse; mustered in as private, Co. A , September 27, 1861, to serve three years; captured near Centreville, Va., August 31, 1862; **killed in action, October 12, 1863, at Sulphur Springs, Va.**[Father applies in February 1872---not granted]

HOLCOMB, FRANKLIN C.—Age, 30 years. Enlisted, October 10, 1861, at North Collins ; mustered in as corporal, Co. E, October 19, 1861, to serve three years; appointed regimental commissary sergeant, June 24, 1862; reduced to ranks and returned to Co. E, date not stated; **wounded in action at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**; discharged for disability, January 31, 1864.[**Died February 6, 1920 at North Collins, NY**]

HORNER, CORTLAND H. — Age, 30 years. Enlisted, September 13, 1862, at Virgil; mustered in as private, Co. L , October, 29, 1862, to serve three years; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863**; appointed corporal, date not stated; wounded and captured, June 24, 1864, at St. Mary's Church, Va. ; died of shell wound, September 9, 1864, at Annapolis, Md.[Widow applies exactly one month later]

LAGRANGE, CASPER. — Age, 31 years. Enlisted, November 19, 1861, at Elmira; mustered in as private, Co. G , November 19, 1861, to serve three years; captured, October 13, 1863; **died of disease, November 28, 1863, at Richmond, Va.** [See 14 pages of widow's pension at www.fold3.com]

McDOUGAL, JAMES H.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, October 3, 1861, at Clyde; mustered in as private, Co. E , October 19, 1861, to serve three years; captured, October 12, 1863, at Sulphur Springs, Va.; **died of disease, April 3, 1864, in Belle Island Prison, Richmond, Va.** [Mother applies on October 15, 1913]

McGUYER, SAMUEL. — Age, 42 years. Enlisted, October 30, 1861, at Cortland; mustered in as private, Co. G, December 3, 1861, to serve three years; appointed commissary sergeant, March 1, 1863; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va, October 12, 1863**; discharged for disability, June 16, 1864, at New York .[Died August 17, 1898?]

NEEB, PHILLIP. — Age, 25 years. Enlisted, September 8, 1861, at Buffalo; mustered in as corporal, Co. C, September 9, 1861, to serve three years; captured at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; **died, August 10, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga.**[#5523 at ANC][NPAF]

NELSON, NEWTON B.—Age, 19 years. Enlisted, December 7, 1861, at Perryville; mustered in as private. Co. B, December 10 , 1861, to serve three years; **captured** at Sulphur Springs, Va , October 12, 1863; mustered out, January 21, 1865, at Elmira, N.Y., expiration term of service. [NPAF]

OLIVER, RICHARD H.—Age, 24 years. Enlisted, October 1, 1861, at Ithaca; mustered in as corporal, Co. D, October 22, 1861, to serve three years; reduced, date not stated; injured, thrown from horse; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 13, 1863; supposed to have died; no further record.**[Widow applies December 23, 1864]

PRATT, GEORGE B. —Age, 23 years. Enlisted, September 30, 1861, at Collins Centre; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 1, 1861, to serve three years; captured, October 14, 1863, at Auburn, Va. ; **died of disease, May 30, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga.**[#1479 at ANC][Widow applies in July 1865]

RANDALL, CALEB. — Age, 33 years. Enlisted, October 14, 1861, at Collins Centre; mustered in as wagoner, Co. D, October 17, 1861, to serve three years; appointed sergeant, January 5, 1863; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, October 12, 1863**; mustered out, October 14, 1864, as sergeant, at Elmira, N.Y.[Invalided in December 1864; died in 1902]

TAYLOR, THOMAS H.—Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 29, 1861, at Phelps; mustered in as private, Co. E , October 19, 1861, to serve three years; captured, October — , 1863; **died, April 11, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga.**[NPAF]

THURSTON, HENRY C — Age, 21 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1862, at Buffalo; mustered in as private, Co. L , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; **captured** at Sulphur Springs, Va., August 11, 1863; paroled, December 28, 1863; appointed sergeant, June 12, 1865; transferred, June 17, 1865, to Co. L, First New York Provisional Cavalry. [**Died April 1, 1924 at Pepperell, MA**]

TILLINGHAST, FREDERICK A,—Age, 28 years. Enlisted, September 5, 1862, at Buffalo; mustered in as private, Co. L , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; no further record.**[Applies as an invalid in January 1884; no death date given]

VAN BROCKLIN, ERIE O.—Age, 19 years. Enlisted, September 11, 1862, at Buffalo; mustered in as private, Co. L , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; **captured**, October 12, 1863, at Sulphur Springs, Va. ; paroled at Richmond, Va., January 14, 1865; mustered out, June 13, 1865, at Annapolis, Md.[Died in 1908]

VAN TUYL, JOHN J.—Age, 19 yearn Enlisted, October 3, 1861, at Prattsburg; mustered in as first sergeant, Co. G , November 16, 1861, to serve three years; **wounded at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863;** re-enlisted, December 17, 1863; mustered in as second lieutenant, April 3, 1864; first lieutenant, May 25, 1864; wounded, October 1, 1864, at Vaughn Road, Va.; mustered in as captain, Co. K , December 24, 1864; captured and escaped at Appomattox Court House, Va., April 9, 1865; mustered out as supernumerary, June 27, 1865, at Cloud's Mills, Va. Commissioned second lieutenant, February 9, 1864, with rank from June 9, 1863, vice King, died; first lieutenant, June 14, 1864, with rank from May 25, 1864, vice McKevitt, discharged; captain, January 16, 1865, with rank from December 24, 1864, vice Hinkley, not mustered.[Died February 28, 1915 at Hot Springs, SD]

WALKER, THOMAS. — Age, 20 years. Enlisted, December 26, 1862, at Buffalo: mustered in as private, Co. M , December 26, 1862, to serve three years; captured at Brandy Station, Va. June 9, 1863; **killed at Sulphur Springs, October 12, 1863,**[NPAF]

WARNER, DANIEL. — Age, 26 years Enlisted, September 15, 1862, at Buffalo: mustered in as private, Co. L , October 29, 1862, to serve three years; appointed corporal, August 1863; **wounded, about October 12, 1863;** discharged for disability, April 10, 1864, at hospital, Washington, D. C.[Died September 18, 1901]

WENDT, FREDERICK. — Age, 18 years. Enlisted, September 18, 1861, at Buffalo; mustered in as private, Co. B , September 18, 1861, to serve three years; **captured** at Brandy Station, Va., June 9, 1863, and at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863,

mustered out, July 1, 1865, at New York city; also appears on roll of Co. A.; also borne as Wentz.[Died November 3, 1917 at Veterans Home in Napa Creek, CA]

WHITE, EBENEZER S.—Age, 23 years. Enlisted, October 11, 1861, at Bouckville; mustered in as private, Co. D, October 22, 1861, to serve three years; captured at Sulphur Springs, October 12, 1863; died of disease, July 8, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga. [#3034 at ANC][NPAF]

WYNKOOP, GUY. — Age, 20 years. Enlisted, October 25, 1861, at Waverly; mustered in, as sergeant, Co. H, November 14, 1861, to serve three years; captured at Sulphur Springs, Va., October 12, 1863; died, August 30, 1864, at Andersonville, Ga., while a prisoner of war. [#7334 at ANC][Father applies in July 1890---not granted]

9 men died in Confederate captivity out of 16 noted as captured at Sulphur Springs. [56% died]
13 men were wounded and survived
3 men were killed in action
1 men died of his wounds

Total casualties were 33

-----At the same battle, about 127 troopers of the 13th PA Cavalry, 157 troopers of the 4th PA Cavalry, and 37 troopers of the 8th PA Cavalry were casualties or captured. At least 189 of them died in captivity or shortly after release, the majority of them at Andersonville, GA.
