SPECIALTY SUMMARY

The Cyber Operations Utilization Field encompasses all functions performed by cyber operations officers to conduct or directly support cyberspace operations and cyberspace training. Inherently included are supervisory and staff functions such as inspection, contingency planning, and policy formulation.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS:

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the FSS and as mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB)
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in applicable regulations

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicant must be less no more than 35 years old upon entering Total Force Officer Training. Must satisfactorily complete an appointment physical. Must qualify for a security clearance. Applicants must be able to meet all requirements PRIOR to interview, to include: obtaining a passing score on the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT), meeting the Air Force Fitness standards as well as the Weight and Body Fat standards.

MANDATORY SCHOOL & TRAINING:

Upon selection, candidate must attend Total Force Officer Training (TFOT), 40 training days at Maxwell AFB, then complete the 6 months Undergraduate Cyber Training course.

EDUCATION:

For entry into this specialty, a Bachelors degree in computer systems or data processing; computer science; computer technology; electrical, computer, systems, or software engineering, telecommunications; information resources management; information systems management; or business administration is desired.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Monitors, and evaluates effectiveness of activities and functions, training programs, readiness of personnel and systems, and operation and adequacy of activities. Ensures necessary operations are conducted to provide command and control, secure and non-secure voice and data, and other battle space effects. Coordinates staff activities pertaining to unit personnel and information management, financial and supply management, planning, and programming to ensure accomplishment of unit mission. Ensures cyberspace operations requirements are met, unique systems are accredited and operators are certified for secure and reliable operation.
- Monitors, and evaluates effectiveness of activities and functions, training programs, readiness of personnel and systems, and operation and adequacy of activities. Ensures necessary operations are conducted to provide command and control, secure and non-secure voice and data, and other battle space effects..
- Directs operations subordinate base cyberspace operations including expeditionary communications, combat communications support, computer systems, engineering and installation, and related information operations. Implements directives from higher headquarters.

KNOWLEDGE:

For award and retention of this AFSC, knowledge is mandatory of network systems operations, industrial control systems, information management; communications; command and control.

EXPERIENCE:

For award of this AFSC, the following experience is mandatory: Experience in a staff-level position in one or more functional areas within cyberspace operations. Experience in base-level fixed or tactical cyber mission areas: establish, operate, defend, exploit, attack.

OSIB:

An Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB) will convene to interview all qualified applicants. Applicants will be informed in writing, or telephonically, of date and time to appear.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Applicants will prepare and forward one copy of the AF Form 24, Application of Appointment as Reserve of the Air Force or USAF Without Component, Copy of AFOQT Scores, Resume, Current Official College Transcripts, Record of Separation/Discharge from the US Armed Forces (if applicable), a Records Review RIP (if applicable).
