SPECIALTY SUMMARY

(As outlined in Air Force Officer Classification Directory, Dated 31 October 2016)

Operates specialized mission aircraft and commands flight crews to accomplish reconnaissance, surveillance, attack, combat, training, and other missions. Related DoD Occupational Group: 220100.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTIONS FACTORS

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applications are subject to review by the FSS Commander. If all mandatory requirements are met, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB).
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for this position. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Applicants considered must qualify with the requirements outlined in ANGI 36-2005 and AFI 36-2005

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Supervises mission planning, equipment configuration, and crew briefing. Ensures ground station and aircraft are preflighted, inspected, loaded, and equipped for mission.
- Operates aircraft and commands crew. Operates aircraft controls and equipment. Performs, supervises, or directs navigation, surveillance, reconnaissance, and weapons employment operations.
- Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.
- Develops plans and policies, monitors operation, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.

KNOWLEDGE: Knowledge is mandatory of theory of flight, air navigation, meteorology, flying directives, aircraft operating procedures, and mission tactics.

EDUCATION: For entry into this specialty,

- An undergraduate degree specializing in physical sciences, mathematics, administration, or management is desirable.

TRAINING: The following **training is mandatory** as indicated:

- For entry into 18AXB, completion of Air Force Undergraduate Remotely Piloted Aircraft Training (URT), or possess an aeronautical rating of Pilot or Navigator/Combat Systems Officer (CSO).
- For award of AFSC 11U3X / 18A3B, completion of transition and operational training in the suffix specific aircraft.

EXPERIENCE: For upgrade to AFSC 11U3X / 18A3X, unit commander determines proficiency based on performance, experience, and completion of minimum training requirements.

OTHER: The following are mandatory as indicated:

For award and retention of this AFSC:

- Current aeronautical rating and no permanent disqualification for aviation service as RPA Pilot.
- For award of AFSC 11U3B / 18A3X, a certification of aircraft commander qualification by appropriate operations authority.
- Specialty requires routine access to Top Secret material or similar environment. For award and retention of AFSC 11U3B, completion of a current Single Scope Background Investigation (SSBI) according to AFI 31-501, Personnel Security Program Management

NOTE 1: Award of the entry level without a completed SSBI is authorized provided an interim Top Secret security clearance has been granted according to AFI 31-501.
