DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (AS OUTLINED IN AFMAN 36-2105)

Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Supervises mission planning, preparation, filing a flight plan, and crew briefing. Ensures aircraft is preflighted, inspected, loaded, equipped, and manned for mission. Pilots aircraft and commands crew. Operates aircraft control and equipment. Performs, supervises, or directs navigation, in-flight refueling, and cargo and passenger delivery. Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training. Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.

QUALIFICATION AND SELECTION FACTORS: Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, sex or National origin. Applications are subject to review by the MPF and as mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB). The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are minimum for Nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in AFI 36-2005 and ANGI 36-2005.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Must be 18 years old. In addition, UPT applicants must be less than 30 years of age prior to entering into formal UPT training. All applicants must submit proof of citizenship and be citizens of the United States IAW Title 32, U.S.C., Section 313. A baccalaureate or higher degree from an educational institution listed in the current Accredited Institutions of Post Secondary Education is required for all appointment. AFOQT: Candidates with a bachelor's degree or higher; at least 25 percentile in the pilot and at least 10 percentile in the navigator composites with a total score in these two being at least 50 percentile and at least 15 percentile in the verbal and at least 10 percentile in the quantitative composites. Candidates with at least 90 semester (135 quarter hours) or more, but no bachelor's degree; minimum of 50 percentile in the pilot and at least 25 percentile in the navigator composites with a total score in these two being at least 90 percentile and at least 30 in the verbal and at least 25 in the quantitative

composites. In exceptional cases, based on the "whole person" or on the "needs of the AF," ANGRC may waive the minimum verbal and quantitative composite scores for persons who apply for appointment to fill ANGUS vacancies.

EDUCATION: For entry into this specialty, undergraduate degree specializing in physical sciences, mathematics, administration or management is desirable.
