SPECIALTY SUMMARY

Leads and performs intelligence activities across the full range of military operations supporting the Air Force's Service Core Function (SCF) of Global Integrated Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR). The Air Force conducts global integrated ISR operations through a five-phase process commonly known by its acronym, PCPAD: planning and direction; collection; processing and exploitation; analysis and production; and dissemination. Additionally, ISR professionals conduct assessment, evaluation, and feedback throughout each phase. Air Force intelligence officers lead Airmen through the PCPAD process across four main areas, also known as functional competencies: Analysis, Collection, Integration, and Targeting.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS:

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the DOS and if mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB)
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined IAW AFI 36-2005 and AFOCD dated April 2019.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: As JFHQ-NY A2 Director of Intelligence; establishes intelligence policy and coordinates on intelligence issues for NYANG Wings.

OSIB:

An Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB) will convene to interview all qualified applicants. Applicants will be informed in writing, or telephonically, of date and time to appear.
