**Mission Description:** Serves as a Plans Officer responsible for developing component plans for setting the theater and joint operations area as well as for planning for the employment of Army Forces in contingencies and campaigns supporting the Geographic Combatant Command's (GCC) Levant-region deliberate planning. These plans are derived from the Guidance for the Employment of the Force, the Joint Strategic Capabilities Plan, and supplemental HQDA guidance. Leads and serves on operational planning teams (OPTs) to determine theater warfighting requirements, solutions, and concepts (to include requirements for the employment of joint and multinational forces) in support of the Army Service Component Command (ASCC) and/or Theater Army. Analyzes the strategic guidance of higher headquarters and applies operational art to address complex problems and frame them for the ASCC/Theater Army leadership. Drives the military decision-making process to develop timely and well-informed recommendations, which inform and support

the Theater Army commander's decision-making. Assignments generally involve extensive contact with other USAREUR staff members. The purpose of contacts is to summarize, interpret, and exchange information on difficult or misunderstood issues; to present and defend results of work; to negotiate with other groups and individuals holding differing viewpoints and goals; and to establish working relationships with other organizations, agencies, universities, or industry. The establishment of contacts is frequently an important aspect of work at this level and requires tact and negotiating skills. Also provides advice and recommendations as required to support branch efforts and priorities. Sets standards, maintains currency in regional political-military affairs, synthesizes staff output, and leads by example. Potential for temporary duty travel within Theater and to CONUS.
