SALARY: Daily military pay equivalent to active duty of corresponding grade, rating and length of service, or \$125 a day, whichever is greater. **Service members cannot be paid for both State Active Duty and Federal Duty on the same day.**

UNIT & LOCATION: Joint Task Force Empire Shield, NYC Metro Area

SELECTING OFFICIAL: Panel Interview

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES: Applicant must be a drilling member in good standing in the New York Army National Guard or New York Air National Guard.

POSITION DESCRIPTION: The Platoon Leader is responsible for planning, directing, and overseeing the successful execution of the platoon's mission. This includes ensuring the operational readiness of all personnel and equipment, while maintaining the health, welfare, morale, and overall discipline of platoon members. This position is assigned to Joint Task Force Empire Shield (JTF-ES) and is located within the New York City metropolitan area. Personnel assigned to the platoon conduct daily missions and operational taskings focused on security operations throughout key NYC metropolitan areas and transit hubs. Duties include conducting presence (foot) patrols to deter, detect, and prevent terrorist activity. JTF-ES seeks highly motivated candidates from the New York Army and Air National Guard who demonstrate sound judgment, strong moral character, leadership ability, professionalism, and physical readiness for duty. This assignment with Joint Task Force Empire Shield is a temporary duty assignment and does not constitute a permanent position. Selection for this position is contingent upon mission requirements, leadership approval, and continued eligibility to serve in accordance with JTF-ES standards and policies.

QUALIFICATION: Applicants must be and remain "in good standing" with their home units. "In good standing" includes:

- Permission from Federal Unit Commander to serve on State Active Duty
- Passing and current AFT/Physical Fitness Test
- Not medically flagged
- BOLC and OTS qualified.
- No visible tattoos while wearing OCPs

- Last three OER/OPB's (If you have not been rated for three years, please submit the OER/OPB's that you have been rated on)

RECOMMENDED DOCUMENTS:

- **Resume**
- **Letter of Recommendation**

The applicant coordinator will acknowledge the receipt of all documents and will inform SM of any issues or discrepancies with the application packet.

All application packets will be deleted after six months. SM's will be required to re-submit all documents once that time frame has been reached.

If a SM is selected to attend the interview panel, the applicant coordinator will contact the SM and provide additional information.
