ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

Applicants must be a drilling member “in good standing” in the New York Army National Guard or New York Air National Guard that can work flexible hours, to include nights and weekends.

**There is no hotel/lodging provided for this mission. SMs must live locally to the respective Air Wing they are applying for.*

NYNG T5/T32 technicians, T32 AGRs, and DMNA-NYS Employees are **not authorized to serve as Security Forces augmentees on this mission.*

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The New York Air National Guard (NYANG) is seeking highly qualified candidates to augment its Security Forces units. We are looking for individuals who demonstrate strong morals, sound judgment, leadership capabilities, and a high level of physical fitness. This is a temporary duty assignment and does not constitute permanent employment.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Service Members will be responsible for supporting base security and force protection. Key duties will include:

- Augmenting existing security personnel.
- Conducting patrols and ensuring the security of assets and personnel.
- Controlling entry and exit points to secure areas.
- Interacting professionally with military members, civilian employees, and visitors.
- Maintaining a safe and secure environment.

QUALIFICATIONS

To be considered for this program, applicants must be and remain “in good standing” with their home units. The criteria for “in good standing” include the following:

Commander’s Approval

Must have permission from you Federal Unit Commanders to serve on State Active Duty.

Physical Fitness

Must have a current (passing) Fitness Assessment

Military Status

Must not be flagged for any reason, medically or otherwise

If selected for the position applicants will need to pass a background check and have a favorable driving record. Each respective Air Wing will provide all essential training.
