- 4. Eligibility Requirements. To be eligible for this position, applicants must:
 - a. Hold the rank of CW4 with \geq 3 years' time in grade (TIG)
- b. Have been or can be awarded MOS W153A and the Aviation Mission Survivability (I) Special Qualification Identifier.
- c. Be designated Unit Trainer (UT) or have Instructor Pilot experience in a MTOE Aviation Unit.
 - d. Not be under any suspensions of favorable personnel actions.
- e. If selected for this position, the applicant must agree, register for and attend the Aviation Warrant Officer Senior Course (AWOSC) or hold the appropriate professional military education (PME) complete.
- 5. Applications. All applications will be submitted to OPM via email through the Field Grade Actions distro at ng.nyarng.list.mnp-opm-field-grade-actions@army.mil no later than the date indicated at the top of this announcement. The following documents should be included in the email:

The president will be the CCWO.
