SPECIALTY SUMMARY

Develops and implements civil engineer (CE) force employment and provides staff supervision and technical advice. Performs and manages CE functions and activities to build, operate, maintain, protect, and recover facilities and infrastructure supporting the United States and allies. Activities include programming, budgeting, project management, drafting, surveying, planning, feasibility studies, construction management, utilities operations, energy and environmental programs, land management, real property accounting, fire protection, explosive ordnance disposal (EOD), readiness and emergency management (EM), family housing and dorm management, and mobilization programs at base level. Serves on response teams and related installation support services. Conducts integrated base response and recovery activities. Advises commanders and government officials on effective use of CE resources. Related DoD Occupational Group: 08X0.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the FSS and as mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB).
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in applicable regulations.
- This is a NEW and CURRENT commissioning opportunity.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must be no more than 40 years old upon entering Total Force Officer Training, applicants with prior military service will use an adjusted age. Must satisfactorily complete an appointment physical. Must qualify for a Secret security clearance. Applicants must be able to meet all requirements PRIOR to interview, to include - obtaining a passing score on the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT), meeting the Air Force Fitness standards (Current Service Members ONLY) as well as the Weight and Body Fat standards.

MANDATORY SCHOOL & TRAINING:

Upon selection, candidates must attend Total Force Officer Training (TFOT); then complete Air Force Civil Engineer Basic Course at Wright-Patterson AFB.

EDUCATION

For entry into this specialty, an ABET-accredited engineering or NAAB-accredited architecture undergraduate or graduate degree is required. You must submit your degree transcripts showing your courseload as part of your hiring package. Your degree and courseload must be reviewed and approved by the Air National Guard Career Field Manager before you will be offered a position. Vagueness or incompleteness will not be adjudicated in your favor. Ultimate waiver authority for a non-qualifying degree is HQ USAF/A4C.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Manage the construction, maintenance, and operation of base facilities, utilities, and infrastructure to ensure continuous mission capability.
 - Lead contingency construction and bare-base operations (e.g., Prime BEEF, RED HORSE) during combat, humanitarian, and disaster relief deployments.
 - Oversee installation emergency management, Fire Emergency Services, and Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) programs to protect personnel and critical assets.
 - Direct comprehensive military construction (MILCON) projects, encompassing planning, architectural design, contracting, and execution oversight.
 - Ensure compliance with environmental regulations, drive energy sustainability initiatives, and manage military real estate, housing, and land use.
- Command, train, and equip squadrons of military and civilian personnel, maintaining strict unit combat readiness and technical engineering proficiency.

KNOWLEDGE:

Must demonstrate strong analytical problem-solving skills, adaptability under pressure, and a clear commitment to leading diverse teams through stressful environments.

EXPERIENCE:

No specialized experience is required for this position.

OSIB:

An Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB) will be convened to interview all qualified applicants. Applicants will be informed in writing, or telephonically, of date and time to appear.

Applicants will prepare and email their application package in one (1) PDF file (Portfolio format WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED). - Record of Separation/Discharge from the US Armed Forces (if applicable)
