TAPS, circa 1862

During the Civil War, when the Union Army unit including Captain Robert Ellicombe was near Harrison's Landing in Virginia, the Confederate Army was on the other side. During the night the Captain heard the moan of a soldier who lay mortally wounded. Not knowing if it was Union or Confederate the Captain decided to bring the stricken man back for medical attention. Crawling on his stomach through the gunfire, he reached the soldier. When the Captain returned to his own lines, he discovered it was a Confederate soldier, dead. The captain lit a lantern, and caught his breath in shock. In the dim light, he saw the face of his own son. The boy has been studying music in the South when the war broke out. Without telling his father, he enlisted in the Confederate Army. Heartbroken, the father asked for a full military burial with members of the Army Band to honor his son despite his enemy status. His request was partially granted. Out of respect for the father, he was given only one musician. The captain chose a bugler. He asked the bugler to play a series of musical notes he found on a piece of paper in the pocket of the dead youth's uniform. This wish was granted. This music was the haunting melody we now know as "Taps" used at military funerals.
