"Military Family Appreciation Month was established in 1993 by the Armed Services YMCA (ASYMCA), with the U.S. Government recognizing the occasion every year since. Annually, the President signs a proclamation declaring November Military Family Month, During his 2012 Proclamation speech, President Obama said that our nation owes 'each day of security and freedom that we enjoy to the members of our Armed Forces and their families. Behind our brave service men and women, there are family members and loved ones who share in their sacrifice and provide unending support.' This annual proclamation marks the beginning of a month-long celebration of the Military Family in which the Department of Defense and the nation will honor the commitment and sacrifices made by the families of the nation's service members."
