# The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

### 1) ADMINISTRATION:

- a. With the approval of a sUAV program for the Naval Militia, we have brought EOCS Pease onboard at DMNA to develop the estimates and proposals for equipment, training, certification, and policy. He will become part of the state UAV Working Group, which meets remotely on a monthly basis. The next meeting is on 7SEP23 at 1300.
- b. The new sUAV program will standup as Detachment 50 under MEBS. CAPT Hawley is developing a distinctive qualification device for certified RPA pilots to wear on their uniforms.
  - c. Yes, the Brazilians are coming. Fingers crossed.
- d. We have received a significant number of applications for the open MEBS mechanic position, at the Leeds Armory. We are still reviewing packages. It is important to understand that the job is in Leeds (Greene County). We will keep the opportunity open until a suitable candidate is found.

### 4) LOGISTICS:

- a. Maintenance issues:
- i. PB 440 will go into Atlantic Service on 6SEP23 for repair/replacement of fuel lines. ETR is 8SEP23.
- ii. LC 350 was found to have fouled plugs on the port engine. They were replaced on 30AUG23. Performance of the boat still appears diminished. We know the bottom needs an extensive cleaning.
  - iii. We are ordering the part to repair the clutch fan relay on Truck 08. ETR TBD.
- b. PB 300 is awaiting parts to repair the lower end unit. Although we are a designated Mercury Marine vendor, we have struggled to get approval to purchase this part (over \$6000) directly from them. We actually have to go through a separate Mercury Marine vendor to make the purchase to satisfy NYS purchasing requirements. The purchase order requisition has been submitted for Coeymans Landing Marina.

## 5) PLANNING AND EXERCISES. Exercise Empire Challenge (ECX 23) Summary:

- a. ECX 23 continues to evolve. With the removal of the JISCC at Jones Beach, we are replacing the primary mission for DET 3 to support UAV operations on Long Island's south shore. We have commitments from both the NY Army National Guard RTI to bring a PUMA quadcopter to operate from LC 351 at Jones Beach, as well as PB 400 at Verplanck. In addition, NYS DHSES OIEC will also have a team to operate their quadcopter in like fashion at Jones Beach. (Note that the previously mentioned RAVEN missions have been scrubbed and replaced by PUMA quadcopter).
- b. Although ECX 23 is fundamentally a communications exercise based on a hurricane scenario in NYC, we are adding two additional pieces that will challenge the command and control of the exercise.
- i. At Saugerties, the USCG Sector NY is coordinating a law enforcement exercise on 3-4 OCT that will include MEBS DET 22 assets. LC 350 should be able to participate in ECX23 using tactical VHF and the airborne repeater to communicate with the CP at Ft. Hamilton.
- ii. At New Rochelle, CTZ 3 is conducting a law enforcement exercise on 4 OCT. We expect PB 230 to also use tactical VHF to make reports as required into the CP.
  - c. PB 301, at Tottenville will have separate taskings related to critical infrastructure.
- d. Unlike 2022, ECX in 2023 will not have a separate, subordinate TF command structure. All remote boats and crews will report directly to JTF 1-NY (JTFES) through the command post at Fort Hamilton. GySgt Hauschen has been designated as the NYNM LNO into the JTF 1-NY structure.
  - e. We are planning to conduct a number of proof-of-concept demonstrations, including:
    - i. UAV (drone) operations from MEBS boats
    - ii. Cross-band voice communications between tactical VHF and HF, from boats to MERN stations state-wide, via ACU-1000M.
    - iii. Digital HF.
    - iv. Tactical VHF over long distances using an airborne repeater.
    - v. Download of UAV video to CP.
