The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

a. Members who served on the Canal Corp events this past summer who were underpaid should have all received their missing BAS checks. With this final payment, MNBF can invoice the Canal Corporation for grant reimbursement. Our next meeting on this subject is 13 JAN 26.

b. We are working with USCG Sector NY to update our Memorandum of Agreement regarding the use of small boats. The last time this document was updated was in 2021 and is due to be updated in February 2026. We have provided them with suggested changes that will include additional support from MEBS DETS 1-3. They are suggesting a ten-year MOA, vice five-year. Once we receive their confirmation of changes back, we will run it up the chain at DMNA for TAG approval.

c. We have also reached out to USCG Sector Eastern Great Lakes to update the MOA we have with them. That document is due for updating in March 2026.

4) LOGISTICS:

b. PB 281 starboard engine shift actuator will be replaced.

c. We are in the process of completely replacing the Webasto diesel heater on LC 350. As this has been a health and safety issue for the JTFES crew, we requested an emergency procurement which was granted by MNBF.

d. The four MEBS trucks that had Telematics battery draining problems have been re-charged. However, this does not really solve the long-term problem. Telematics will continue to drain batteries. MNFE Fleet Services has been notified.
