


Subj: OPSUM 4 OCT 2024 MEBS PROGRAM

The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

- a. The budget for MEBS Proficiency Training for the current State Fiscal Year is nearly exhausted. All members who have approved paid SAD orders through 21 October are still good. Any SAD requests for pay that have not already been approved, either before or after 21 October are not likely to be approved.
- b. We are projecting that MK1 Nugent, EM1 Malik, and BM2 Teixeira will travel to Laconia, NH for Mercury Marine technician courses (EFI Systems and SmartCraft), 9 12 Dec 24.
- c. We have formally accepted the FY 2024 Port Security Grant award for PB440 maintenance.
- 2) INFORMATION: The East Coast dock worker strike has been temporarily resolved. The dock workers are back on the job until January 2025. During the recent strike, the port was very quiet.























3) OPERATIONS:

- a. Training platforms will conduct remaining seasonal events over the next three weeks.
 - i. After completing a fam visit to NRC Buffalo on 6 OCT, the WESTCOM boats will travel to Rochester for a fam visit on 18-19 OCT. The two boats will then be moved to Leeds on 20 OCT.
 - ii. PB 230 will be moved from New Rochelle to Leeds on 21 OCT, with training events enroute.
 - iii. PB 220 will train on 21 OCT, and then be recovered to Leeds.


