### The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

## 1) ADMINISTRATION:

a. UAV Program Update:

i. EOCS Scott Pease has completed a week of SAD at Latham cobbling together proposals for the NYNM UAV program. The following are the intentions going forward.

ii. Our initial plan will include a new MEBS DET 50 with 3-6 personnel focused on UAV operations. At least two will be FAA Part 107 certified Remote Pilot in Charge (RPIC). We have two members who are near completion of this requirement already.

iii. We have a proposed training and proficiency plan that will take advantage of DHSES opportunities at the State Preparedness Training Center in Oriskany.

iv. We have joined the state UAV Working Group and participated in our first virtual meeting on 7SEP23. As a member, we will have preferred access to the limited training opportunities.

v. TAG has limited our equipment acquisition to those products available on the Blue UAV clear list. From that list, we have identified the Vespar sUAS bundle from Vantage Robotics as our primary candidate for purchase through GSA. The bundle is \$9,292.48. We have already received the required purchase order document (APP A) from the vendor.

vi. EOCS Pease has developed a draft policy, training, and qualifications document that we expect will be turned into a NYNM Instruction.

b. We have whittled down the candidates for the MEBS second mechanic position at Leeds. There are currently four viable candidates.

## 2) INFORMATION:

a. (DAILYMAIL.CO.UK) Long Island couple killed in boat crash after twice bigger fishing vessel and capsizing as divers recover wife's body still inside the cabin. A New York couple was killed over Labor Day Weekend after their boat crashed with a vessel twice as big and capsized. The bodies of Louis Deritis, 53, and his wife Renee, 50, were recovered in Great South Bay near Fire Island after their boat capsized on Sunday night.



Deritis was operating his 27-foot 1989 OC/MA boat when it collided with a 44-foot fishing boat. He was ejected from the vessel and his body was found in the water on Monday after an overnight search. Renee's body was earlier found in the partially submerged boat's cabin by a team of rescue divers, police said. The larger boat was operated by Ferdinand Caravousanos, 61, who was on a fishing trip with friends and not injured. The West Babylon resident's four passengers were not hurt in the collision. Suffolk County police said the incident appears to be a 'tragic accident.' Chief William Scrima said on Monday that Caravousanos's vessel, the Henriques, was heading southwest in the bay while Deritis's boat was heading east. At some point, for reasons unknown, Deritis's boat made an abrupt turn north and into the path of the Henriques. While Caravousanos made his best effort to swerve, he could not avoid colliding with the Deritis' boat. Chief Scrima could not say at what speed the boats were traveling. He added there's no reason to believe alcohol or drugs were a factor in the tragic crash.

b. (CBSNEWS New York) Boat sinks after catching fire near City Island A boat caught fire near City Island on Tuesday. The FDNY says the boat caught fire after crashing into a pillar in the area just before 6 p.m.Officials say about 60 FDNY members responded to the fire and were able to prevent flames from spreading to the dock and surrounding buildings. The boat sank around 6:30 p.m. Police say a 41-year-old man suffered severe arm trauma. A police officer applied a tourniquet, and the patient was taken to a local hospital in stable condition.
















b. Ventilate all spaces before restarting engine after fueling

c. Always be mindful of speed, especially at night or during periods of reduced visibility

- d. Energize all running lights e. CBDR Constant Bearing Decresing Range
- f. Maintain a lookout
- g. Use Sound Signals





h. Utilize VHF radio to communicate
i. Change course sufficiently so as to be obvious to other vessel
j. Utilize radar
k. 5 short blasts = DANGER!!!
