The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

a. We have added a feature in MEBS LOG to report significant operational events. Whenever a significant event occurs, especially when dealing with outside agencies. A good example is responding to requests for search and rescue. By making these incident reports, we are capturing this information for historical records. 

4) LOGISTICS:

a. PB 440 is NMC for the scheduled Hamilton Jet service life extension project. We are projecting that the boat will be down for two weeks. PB 300 is currently the replacement on the DET TWO mission. We anticipate that PB 301 will take over effective 12JUN23.

PB 400 port shaft noise update: During the testing of PB400 on 8JUN23, a chirping sound was b. detected which seemed to become more pronounced after bringing the boat up to near 2000 RPM. Initially we were underway at 1000, 1500, and then finally at 2000 RPM in 5-minute intervals. After coming back down to 500 RPM the sound was very detectable and seemed to be primarily coming from the port shaft. The observation of both the crew, N4, and Lou from FPS is the sound becomes more noticeable the longer the shafts are spinning at higher RPMs. Intent: Following the scheduled OP on 6/16 we have Viking Boat Yard haul-out PB400 for an inspection of the cutlass bearings, shafts, and shaft seal area under the hull. The expected outcome is the shafts will both need to be pulled in order for a thorough inspection of both the bearings and the shaft. All contact points will be examined and a corrective action to resolve this issue and increase the service life of the components is our goal. The worst case scenario is the shafts will require resurfacing and the bearings have to be replaced immediately. It is possible that resurfacing the shafts may correct the issue and the bearings currently installed are still salvageable. Our inspection is to see how the shaft is rotating and signs of where/how this chirping sound is being generated (And resolve). We intend to haul the boat out of the water on or after 20JUN23 for shaft removal and inspection. We anticipate the boat will be NMC for one week.

c. Truck 74 will go into the dealership for recall repairs to the DEF heater. ETR is 12JUN23.

d. PB 300 is experiencing issues with the DTS (digital throttle system) that is giving swinging tach readings for the engines. The boat is also experiencing limited speed. We intend to replace PB 300 on the DET TWO mission on 12JUN23 with PB 301, currently at Indian Point.
