## The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

### 1) ADMINISTRATION:

- a. Promotion Considerations for 2024. The new NYNM promotion instruction has been promulgated. We want to make clear to everyone that is considering a NYNM promotion opportunity understands that the success or failure the promotion package rests largely with the individual. Read and understand the new instruction. If you have questions, get them answered by a knowledgeable resource. Do not speculate or just guess on what is beneficial to your package. As we are in somewhat of a transition from the old process to the new, every candidate should ensure that your professional history (going back at least five years) is explained. This includes time that you may not have been in the Naval Militia or in the Reserves. Use your cover letter as a means to explain where you were or what you did that could add to your substance to your package. (Civilian accomplishments may be an additional justification.) Do not assume that what worked in the past will work now. If you have gaps in your professional record, work now to get the record made on paper. Everyone considering promotion should ensure that you have an annual evaluation. If it shows steady improvement, that is a plus.
- b. The purchase of a new drone is in progress. The intent is to purchase the Vesper bundle from Vantage Robotics, of San Leandro, CA. This particular drone is approved for use by TAG. We have been awaiting the registration of Vantage Robotics into the New York State Financial System (SFS). That is complete and the vendor now has a SFS ID number. OGS confirmed yesterday that it is in order and the creation of the purchase order is the next step.



a. The new F350 trucks have received their new caps.



## b. Maintenance issues:

- i. LC 351 will have cowl bezels installed on 16 NOV at Jones Beach. The cowl bezels are designed to prevent the inadvertent finger damage when working with the engine cowling. This is the first job that will be warranty covered by our authorized Mercury Marine technician. We will receive credit in our Mercury account that can be used for future purchases.
- ii. PB 300 remains NMC at Leeds. The port engine power head drive shaft seal repair will take place early next week. Anticipate completion of this job by 15NOV. however, both lower end units require



















repair/replacement. We may be able to fashion one working lower end unit from parts on hand. We will need to order another lower end unit. ETR TBD.

- We are making the calculated decision to not repair the clutch fan relay on Truck 08. Due to the expense related to this repair and the likelihood that the same problem could reoccur, we are going to keep the status of Truck 08 as PMC, although for practical purposes, it is FMC.
