#### 1) ADMINISTRATION:

- a. We are experiencing some issues with SAD orders requests. Some of these problems are at MEBS HQ. We have had some service members submit SAD requests that have not gone through the JotForm workflow correctly (Service Member requests SAD SAD Prescreen via NYNM mailbox MEBS CDR approval SAD orders written and sent to member via NYNM mailbox). We have conducted tests of the system, and it appears to work the way it is designed. However, we are also aware that some requests have not made it through the workflow, and we do not have an explanation. Everyone who submits a SAD order request through MEBS LOG should get an acknowledgement email, AND once an order request is approved, a second email. Once you get the second acknowledgement, your SAD orders should be sent to you via email.
- b. Regarding SAD, everyone must be on written NYNM orders to perform either short term or long-term (standing mission) orders. Despite the glitches above, you must have written acknowledgement authorizing you to be on SAD.
