The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

a. We have more than \$19,250 in federal reimbursable awaiting recoupment from FEMA for the FY2024 Port Security Grant. We have not been able to submit for reimbursement due to FEMA's furlough.

b. The updated Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between NYS DMNA and US Sector NY is being routed within the agency. Upon approval by TAG, it will be sent to the Captain of the Port for finalization.

c. In anticipation of major work that is desired to be completed on PB 440 in the next year or so, we are planning an amendment to the current five-year maintenance contract that we have with Atlantic Service & Equipment. The current contract (C000923) expires on 30SEP27. Based on the current contract, there is only \$122,730 remaining (of which \$38,000 is fenced for a one-time paint job). We have projects that could add an additional \$78,000 or more to the contract before it expires. Naturally, these projected expenses are largely (75%) reimbursable under the FY2024 Port Security Grant. We met with MNBF on 11MAR26 and based on that meeting, we are putting together our proposal which we expect to submit next week.
