

### 5) PLANNING AND EXERCISES.

a. Operation Mohawk Arrow. The 2nd WMD-CST will plan, resource and host the 4th Annual Region 1 multi-CST event in Capital District New York 09-13 June 2025. To incorporate federal, local and state partners into a multi-day all hazards response exercise in order to validate a Regional Response Concept and interoperability among partner agencies and CST's. #### 6) COMMUNICATIONS.

- a. The Commander, NYNM has approved the proposal to transition the MEBS command post and assets to the NYNM UAS unit as a combined maritime domain awareness capability. This transition is starting and should be completed by the end of June 2025.
- b. The communicators are slated to participate in a multi-agency response communications exercise at Oriskany between 12-16 MAY.



### Multi-Agency Response Communications Exercise (COMMEX) May 12 - 16, 2025

#### Exercise Description

A two-day, full-scale exercise designed for a multi-agency response to a severe weather event in the State of New York. The exercise will incorporate real-life scenarios that will reinforce the principles and skills learned in previous courses or incidents. The exercise will focus on emergency communications support to public safety agencies, first responders and emergency management organizations. Tasks are designed to simulate challenges that would be encountered during the response to a real-world response incident.

The exercise is presented with an introductory day for orientation and explanation of the exercise, safety briefing, and a walk through of communications assets that will be included in the exercise. This offering will include interactive discussions and inter-agency collaboration and networking. The exercise will conclude with a Hot Wash and an evaluation of the offering.

The Exercise will be led and supported by the Exercise Planning Team. This team consists of stakeholders and personnel from the following agencies: DHSES-OIEC, DHSES-OFPC, the NYSP, DMNA, DEC, DOH, Oneida County DES, City of Rome, and DHSES-OEM.

This exercise is for participants that are currently seeking to practice and exercise skills to maintain proficienc and knowledge, while working in the capacity to support their agency's response to an incident

OIEC is encouraging those who have completed an INTD course to register as we are looking to fill several INTD roles during the exercise. We are also searching for functional communications volunteer role players from the NYS COMU Program or partnered agencies. Please submit an email to OIEC Training@dhsnes.nv.gov to express interest.
