a. Naval Militia Membership Update: per OTAG retired members of the Naval Militia will now be counted as part of our 5%er number. OTAG 10-1 Naval Militia Regulations is being updated currently. 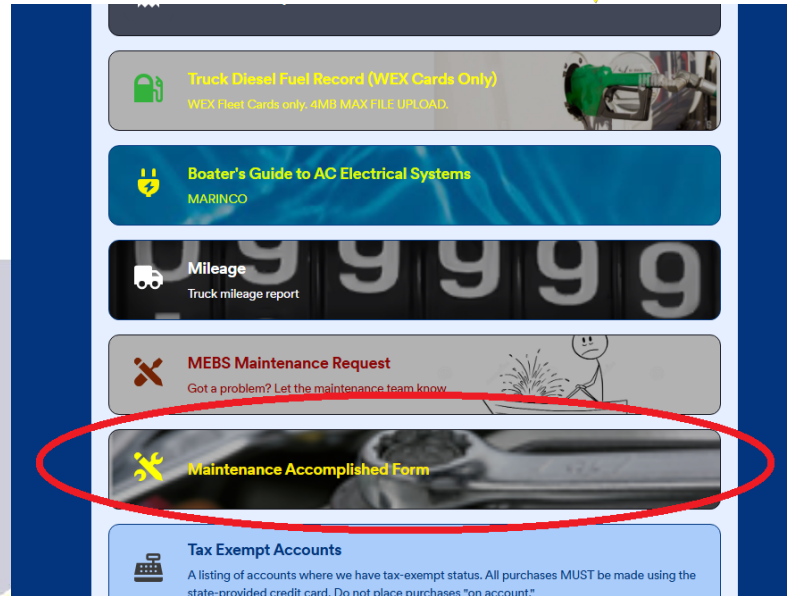

a. Until further notice, all maintenance issues that would normally be sent to MKC Soto should be directed to CAPT McKnight.

c. We have received notification from Coast Guard Station New York that PB440 will need to be relocated following the conclusion of Op Sail 250 due to planned bulkhead renovation projects that are expected to last several months. At this time, we are actively conducting research and due diligence to identify suitable alternative berthing locations. The anticipated relocation date is 15 July. One of the primary concerns is the potential duration of the project, which may extend into the winter months. As a result, we must identify a location that will remain accessible year-round and will not be adversely impacted by ice conditions.

d. The last MEBS truck that has a pending Ford recall is currently at Lacy Ford in Catskill getting the work taken care of. All others have been done.
