The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

- a. Responses to the call for paid training are getting traction, especially in SOUTHCOM and NORTHCOM. As expected, there is something of a learning curve to the new requirements. We have made some administrative corrections to help streamline the process. Here are some notes of interest:
 - i. The required Pre and Post Deployment Medical Screening Forms are now available as fillable documents on MEBS LOG. You no longer need to download these forms, just fill out and submit from the app and the information will get to NYNM HQ.
 - ii. When completing the SAD Attendance Register, some members are experiencing a CAPTCHA feature requiring the applicant to match pictures. According to JOTFORM, this is a feature that gets activated when there is a lot of activity on the APP. We are working to get this feature turned off. Right now, it is still there.
- b. There is a policy change that is good news for members of MEBS who are assigned to another full-time mission such as Asylum Seeker Resource Support (ASRS). The requirement to account for a day taken to conduct MEBS training in an "M" status is rescinded. By going in an "M" day status, you were required to lose that day of pay.

Now, you can conduct MEBS training in either a "P" (Pass Day) or "L" (Leave Day) status. Your choice. This way you will no longer lose a day of pay to conduct training. Note that this policy does not affect your ASRS schedule. MEBS training will never supersede your operational mission tasking, and can only be scheduled as your operational commitments allow.

Also, note that you will still need a set of orders from NYNM to go on no-cost SAD to conduct the MEBS training.


