The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

a. MEBS planning for involvement in SAIL 250 events in both Albany and NYC continues. To date, requirements have not been settled. We intend to gather more details during the AMSC meeting in Brooklyn on 29APR. CAPTs Dutcher and McKnight, and Maj Cinturati to attend.

b. We were approved for 2026 grant to support NYS Canal Corporation patrols of the state canal system. The value of the grant is \$10,000 and is to be used to offset personnel and fuel costs associated with these patrols.

4) LOGISTICS:

a. PB 440 port exhaust system repairs completed. Vessel is FMC.

b. PB 400 engine work continues at New Hamburg by Stormy Bay Marine Services. Identified growth work includes repairs to both port and starboard cylinder heads. Due to the increase in cost over the \$50,000 threshold, additional controls have been put in place that must be satisfied before approval by MNBF is granted. The vendor has provided needed documents and MNBF is working with NYS OSC to complete the paperwork.

c. PB 301 repower and gauge installation complete. The boat will replace PB 300 with MEBS DET ONE so that the break-in period can be completed by them. PB 301 will transition to Tottenville for DET ELEVEN.

d. Truck 27 is NMC due to a warranty repair required for the tele-metrics computer onboard. The part is on back order with Lacy Ford, in Catskill.

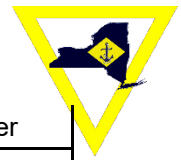
e. LC 351 will move to Jones Beach o/a 30APR 26.
