1) ADMINISTRATION:

- b. Whenever an issue arises where the words "boat" and "naval militia" happen in the same sentence, chances are extremely likely that it is a MEBS issue. If you have a MEBS issue, it is proper to address it through your MEBS chain of command. That means that if there is a training, exercise, personnel, or equipment issue, the FIRST PERSON to discuss it with is your MEBS Regional Coordinator.
- c. All boat VISA credit cards will expire in June 2025. Replacement cards (good for 3 years) are on the way and expected by the middle of May. They will be distributed from NYNM HQ.
 - d. All Visa credit card purchase receipts must be itemized and match the R1 Form.

- 2) INFORMATION: Mariners are advised that, conditions permitting, all portions of the New York State Canal system are scheduled to open Friday, May 16, 2025, for the annual Navigation Season. As the Canal Corporation continues to recruit seasonal staff, lock operating hours may differ from previous seasons at various locations. All mariners are encouraged to read the schedule below carefully. As staff positions are filled, hours will be adjusted and communicated through the Notice to Mariners notification program. There are no tolls or fees for recreational use of the Canal system this year.

The hours of operation for the 2025 season are as follows: Standard hours of operation are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily until November 3, 2025.

4) LOGISTICS:

- a. PB 400 had received some bad diesel fuel from the vendor and reported on 11APR. We initially placed the vessel NMC due to the apparent extent of the problem. However, with a change of fuel filters, it looks like we will get by. The boat is FMC. However, we are planning a comprehensive cleaning of the fuel tanks on this vessel.
- b. LC351 Was moved from HPBA to Kingston City Marina yesterday 4/23/2025. Additionally, a total of 4.6 hours motor time was completed and the "Break In" of the new Seapro motors is going well (No issues).



















c. PB281 - Repowering with V8 4 Stroke 250 HP motors. The shaft conversion was completed, and the PORT lower unit was not correct. Coeymans completed "Rework" and the motors have been completed configuration for usage on this asset. Today the N4 shop attempted to "Wet test" and Sea trial this asset. Motors both run but seem to be running hot. Port motor has a slight ringing rattle sound that we have not yet been able to identify. Both motors were running hot. Asset returned to shop to check the function of thermostats. Coeyman's Landing Marina has been notified of the ringing sound from Port motor via voice mail. We will continue trouble shooting and advise.
