4) LOGISTICS:

Regarding the inadequate support on the LC 351 trailer, we are working with Munson Boats a. and more directly with Tuff Trailer to resolve the issue. We have sent them photos and measurements so they can develop a plan to send us corrective parts. Fundamentally, we need additional bunk boards on the forward end of the trailer.

b. Maintenance issues:

PB 400 shaft repair work. The new propeller shafts and couplers have been obtained i. by FPS Propeller, in Ravena, We will deliver the shafts to Stormy Bay Marine Services next week so they can make the installation in the boat.

PB 301, on mission with DET 1 suffered a lower end casualty. The lower end was ii. swapped out with PB 300's, which is already NMC due to port engine oil seal failure. PB 301 is now FMC, while PB 300 now has multiple issues with the port Verado engine. We are still troubleshooting, but expect complete replacement of the lower end unit in order to make the boat FMC. At this point, the ETR is 10CT23.

Upon return of PB 400 to DET 1, we expect to relocate PB 301 to Tottenville as a iii. training asset for DET 11.

Truck 08 (Rochester) suffered an overheating problem on the evening of 27JUL. It iv appears that the clutch fan actuator is malfunctioning. We have determined that the truck should not tow anything until repaired. As a result, we are replacing both Truck 08 and Truck 09 with Truck 39 and Truck 40 respectively.
