The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

a. NYS Office of General Services (OGS) is installing TELEMATICS in each state-owned vehicle. Once installed, each MEBS driver must scan an RFID card that records who is driving, and additional data for each MEBS truck. Each MEBS member will receive an RFID card once we get them at headquarters. The RFID will be specifically tagged to the individual, so they cannot be shared. OGS wanted to start installation of the telematics on MEBS truck in early September. We have reached out to OGS to defer the scheduling of this work due to the limited number of staff now working.
