August is Back to School Safety

From 2012 to 2021, about 70% of the deaths in school bus-related crashes were occupants of vehicles other than the school bus, and 16% were <u>pedestrians</u>. About 5% were school bus passengers, 5% were school bus drivers, and 3% were <u>pedalcyclists</u>.



National Safety Council – School Safety Checklist



- Choose ergonomic backpacks
- · Have children use both shoulder straps
- Should weigh no more than 5% to 10% of your child's body weight



- Wear a helmet when riding a bicycle to school and wear bright colors
- Ride on the right side of the road, with traffic, and in a single file
- Come to a complete stop before crossing the street; walk bikes across the street


